

WHEREAS, Georgia State Senator Brandon Beach has been named United States Treasurer by President Donald J. Trump; Senator Beach will be the first Georgian to hold this esteemed position; and



WHEREAS, Senator Beach's national position as Treasurer is responsible for the U.S. Mint and Fort Knox, and serves as a liaison to the Federal Reserve; the Treasurer also serves as senior advisor to the Treasury Secretary on issues relating to community development; and



WHEREAS, Senator Beach was elected to the Georgia State Senate in 2013 representing District 21, which includes portions of Cherokee and Fulton counties; he also serves as Chairman of the Senate Committee on Economic Development and Tourism, and as an Ex-Officio member of the Senate Committees on Higher Education, Reapportionment and Redistricting, and Transportation, and a member of the Senate Committees on Appropriations, Finance, Rules, and the Committee on Assignments; and



WHEREAS, Senator Beach is the Executive Director and one of the founders of the North Fulton Community Improvement District, which has invested more than \$28 million and contributed to over \$170 million in new infrastructure over the past 20 years; and



WHEREAS, Governor Sonny Perdue appointed Sen. Beach to the board of the Georgia Regional Transportation Authority (GRTA) in 2001, and he was selected to GRTA's Land Development Committee; he was

he was selected to GRTA's Land Development Committee; he also elected to the Board of the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) in 2008 until 2013, and served as Chairman of the Public-Private Partnership Committee; and



WHEREAS, Senator Beach was a former member of the Fulton County

Development Authority, where he served as Chairman, and a current member of the Georgia World Congress Center Oversight Board, the Georgia Lottery Corporation Oversight Board, and the Alpharetta Rotary; additionally, he is a former member of the Board of Trustees at King's Ridge Christian School;
