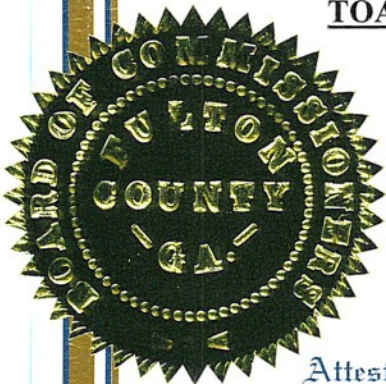


WHEREAS,
