

Redistricting Needed to Reflect Population Changes from 2020 Census




2022 District Population Target 177,785 +/- 5%

- Meet population targets


MAP OPTION A:

- Meets population targets within +/- 5%




MAP OPTION B:

Selected map provided to legislative delegation chair.

Sponsor submits BOC selected map to OLCR for technical review and certification.

Formal Presentation of Map to Delegation

OCLR Certifies map or informs of edits needed

Certified map sent to Legislative Counsel by Sponsor

Board of Commissioners Formal Adoption of Certified Map Plan Sponsor Introduces Legislation for Adopted Map in Georgia House of Representative (Hopper)

Passage of Map Legislation

Transmittal of new maps/districts to Fulton Department of Registration & Elections

Secretary of State – New District Lines/Data Deadline
