A RESOLUTION APPROVING A RADIO COMMUNICATIONS TOWER LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND THE GEORGIA TECHNOLOGY AUTHORITY, FOR PREMISES LOCATED AT 5651 STONEWALL TELL ROAD, COLLEGE PARK, GEORGIA, FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2025, WITH NINE (9) ANNUAL RENEWAL TERMS, AT NO MONETARY RENTAL COST TO THE COUNTY; AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE LEASE AGREEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO APPROVE THE LEASE AGREEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENTS AS TO FORM AND TO MAKE ANY MODIFICATIONS THERETO PRIOR TO EXECUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Fulton County's Department of Emergency Services ("FC Emergency Services") is the cornerstone of the County's comprehensive public safety response system with a main objective of facilitating the flow of information during an emergency in a seamless and rapid manner, and providing aid, comfort, and instructions to the public prior to the arrival of Law Enforcement, Fire, and Emergency Medical Services; and

WHEREAS, FC Emergency Services also operates the Emergency Communications Center and is responsible for managing the largest public safety radio system in Georgia with more than 6,000 users; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Technology Authority ("GTA") owns and is responsible for the management of a cell tower facility located at 5651 Stonewall Tell Road, situated in College Park, Georgia ("Tower"); and

WHEREAS, Fulton County (as tenant) and GTA (as landlord) previously entered into a Radio Communications Tower Lease Agreement, as approved by the Board of Commissioners as Agenda Item 15-0316 on April 15, 2015 ("Prior Lease Agreement"), pursuant to which GTA granted Fulton County a lease to place communications equipment on the Tower, which supported FC Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, it is the mutual desire of Fulton County and GTA that Fulton County continue to place and maintain communications equipment on the Tower, and to execute a new Radio Communication Tower Lease Agreement for the purpose of formalizing the rental terms for such placement and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Real and Asset Management, FC Emergency Services, and GTA have negotiated mutually acceptable rental terms for a new Radio Communication Tower Lease Agreement, including an initial term from the effective date through December 31, 2025 with nine (9) optional annual renewal terms thereafter, and no monetary rental cost to the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-60-13, each county or municipality in this state shall be authorized to enter into multiyear lease, purchase, or lease purchase contracts of all kinds for the acquisition of goods materials, real and personal property, services and supplies, and pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-10-1, all contracts entered into by
