

Proclamation



WHEREAS, Brother Lieutenant Colonel Mark W. Hill, a proud son of Morehouse College (Class of 1967), was initiated into the Bond of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated April 7, 1966 through the distinguished Pi Chapter, and has remained a faithful, dedicated, and exemplary member of this Brotherhood for more than sixty years; and



WHEREAS, Brother Hill rendered extraordinary service to our Nation as a decorated combat arms officer in the United States Army, reaching the rank of Lieutenant Colonel — answering the call of duty in the Republic of Vietnam, and again during Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm in Saudi Arabia — demonstrating the highest qualities of courage, leadership, and sacrifice that define the Kappa Man; and



WHEREAS, upon his honorable retirement from active military service, Brother Hill, devoted nine years to the education of Atlanta's youth as a mathematics teacher, and he served as Chief of Staff of PEER Consultants, P.C., a leading international environmental engineering firm — where he helped steward vital infrastructure including oversight of the Blue Plains Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility and the nation's first biodegradable refuse facility; and



WHEREAS, Brother Hill also served as a board member of the Selfridge Army Credit Union, a leader in financial stewardship at Gillfield Baptist Church and Union Baptist Church, Vice President of Region IV of the Morehouse National Alumni Association, and a member of the Maryland Governor's Food Center Authority — all bearing witness to a life lived in achievement; and



WHEREAS, The White Coat is among the most hallowed honors that Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity bestows — a sacred garment reserved for those Brothers whose decades of unwavering fidelity, distinguished achievement, and steadfast service to fraternity, community, and country have earned them a permanent place in the annals of this Brotherhood;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Fulton County Board of Commissioners recognize Brother Mark W. Hill for his extraordinary 50-year Commitment to Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., his lifetime of professional excellence, and his lasting impact on both his community and his fraternity, standing as a true testament to a life lived with purpose and achievement, and does hereby proclaim Saturday, May 23, 2026, as "**BROTHER MARK W. HILL APPRECIATION DAY**" in Fulton County, Georgia.
