WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Powers Law (O.C.G.A. § 36-44-1 et seq.) provides for the establishment of redevelopment powers and the creation of redevelopment plans and tax allocation districts by counties and municipalities in the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Redevelopment Powers Law, the Atlanta City Council (the "Council"), adopted the Princeton Lakes Redevelopment Plan and established Tax Allocation District Number Four - Princeton Lakes (the "Princeton Lakes TAD") by resolution adopted on November 18, 2002, and approved by the Mayor on November 26, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Powers Law provides that county ad valorem property taxes derived from a municipal tax allocation district may be included in the computation of tax allocation increments of the district if the governing body of the county consents to such inclusion by resolution; and

31 32 **WHEREAS**, on December 10, 2002, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners authorized Fulton County's participation in the Princeton Lakes TAD via Fulton County Resolution 02-1414, consenting to the inclusion of Fulton County's ad valorem property taxes on real property within the Princeton Lakes TAD in the computation of the tax allocation increment for the Princeton Lakes TAD; and

WHEREAS, since the inception of the Princeton Lakes TAD on December 31, 2002, Fulton County has contributed \$14,646,525 to the Princeton Lakes TAD; and

WHEREAS, in 2022 alone, Fulton County contributed \$1,219,057 to the Princeton Lakes TAD; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Redevelopment Powers Law, the Atlanta City Council adopted the Eastside Redevelopment Plan and established the Tax Allocation District Number Five - Eastside (the "Eastside TAD") by resolution adopted on December 1, 2003, and approved by the Mayor on December 9, 2003; and

44 45 **WHEREAS**, on December 17, 2003, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners authorized Fulton County's participation in the Eastside TAD via Fulton County Resolution 03-1465, consenting to the inclusion of Fulton County's ad valorem property taxes on real property within the Eastside TAD in the computation of the tax allocation increment for the Eastside TAD; and

WHEREAS, since the inception of the Eastside TAD on December 31, 2003, Fulton County has contributed \$51,604,996 to the Eastside TAD; and

WHEREAS, in 2022 alone, Fulton County contributed \$6,315,471 to the Eastside TAD; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County is currently allocating eight and a half percent (8.5%) of the overall Fulton County tax digest to the County's participation in TADs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners understands that the Princeton Lakes and Eastside TADs have no outstanding bond debt (subject to confirmation), and may have reached substantial completion; and

WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing, the Board of Commissioners has decided to place limitations on Fulton County's ad valorem property tax increments being included and utilized in certain TADs, where Fulton County has no existing obligation requiring Fulton County's continued participation so that such funds can be redeployed to support essential funding which is needed to support public safety, health and other essential services; and

WHEREAS, as stewards of public funds, the Board of Commissioners finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Fulton County to end the County's participation in the Princeton Lakes and Eastside TADs, conditioned on County staff verifying that there are no outstanding obligations that require the County's continued participation in these TADs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners also finds it necessary for County staff to actively review all remaining TADs in which the County participates to determine whether the County can discontinue its participation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County, Georgia, hereby repeals Resolution 02-1414 and Resolution 03-1465 consenting to the inclusion of certain Fulton County taxes in the computation of the tax allocation increment for the Princeton Lakes and Eastside TADs contingent upon findings that that all bond debt and other redevelopment obligations for the Princeton Lakes and Eastside TADs have been met or no longer exist.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that County Staff is hereby directed to work with the County Manager to confirm that all bond debt and redevelopment obligations have been met for the Princeton Lakes and Eastside TADs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, upon verification that all bond debt and redevelopment obligations have been met, the County Manager is hereby authorized and directed

to send notice to the City of Atlanta of the Board of Commissioners' decision to discontinue the County's participation in the Princeton Lakes and Eastside TADs. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that County Staff is hereby directed to continue to actively review all other TADs in which the County participates to determine whether bond debt and redevelopment obligations have been met with respect to those TADs. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if Staff determines that all bond debt and redevelopment obligations have been met with respect to any remaining TADs, Staff is directed to present a Resolution to the Board of Commissioners repealing and discontinuing the County's participating in those specific TADs. BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption and that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. **PASSED AND ADOPTED** by the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County, Georgia, this 21st day of December, 2022.
