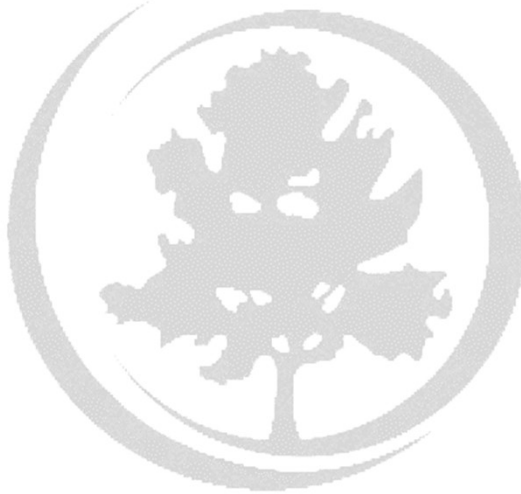

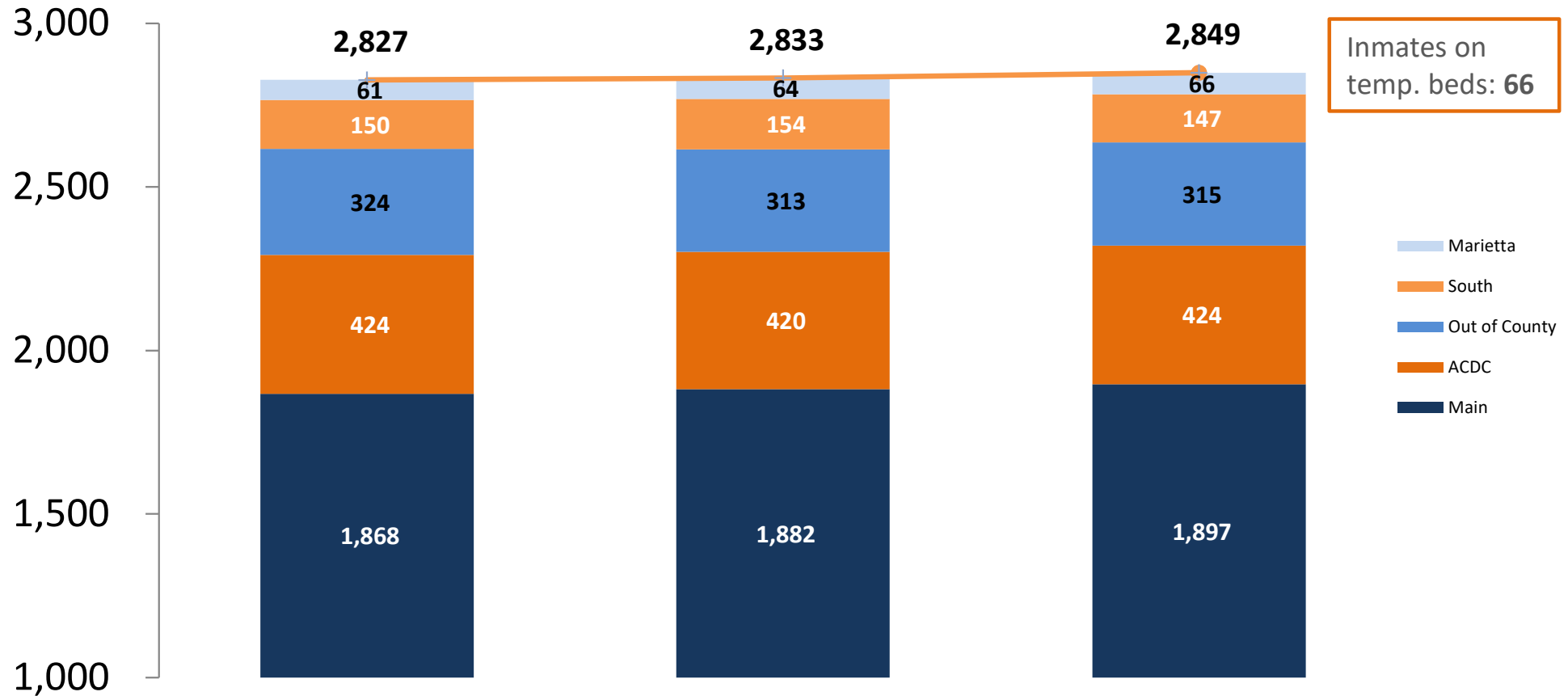

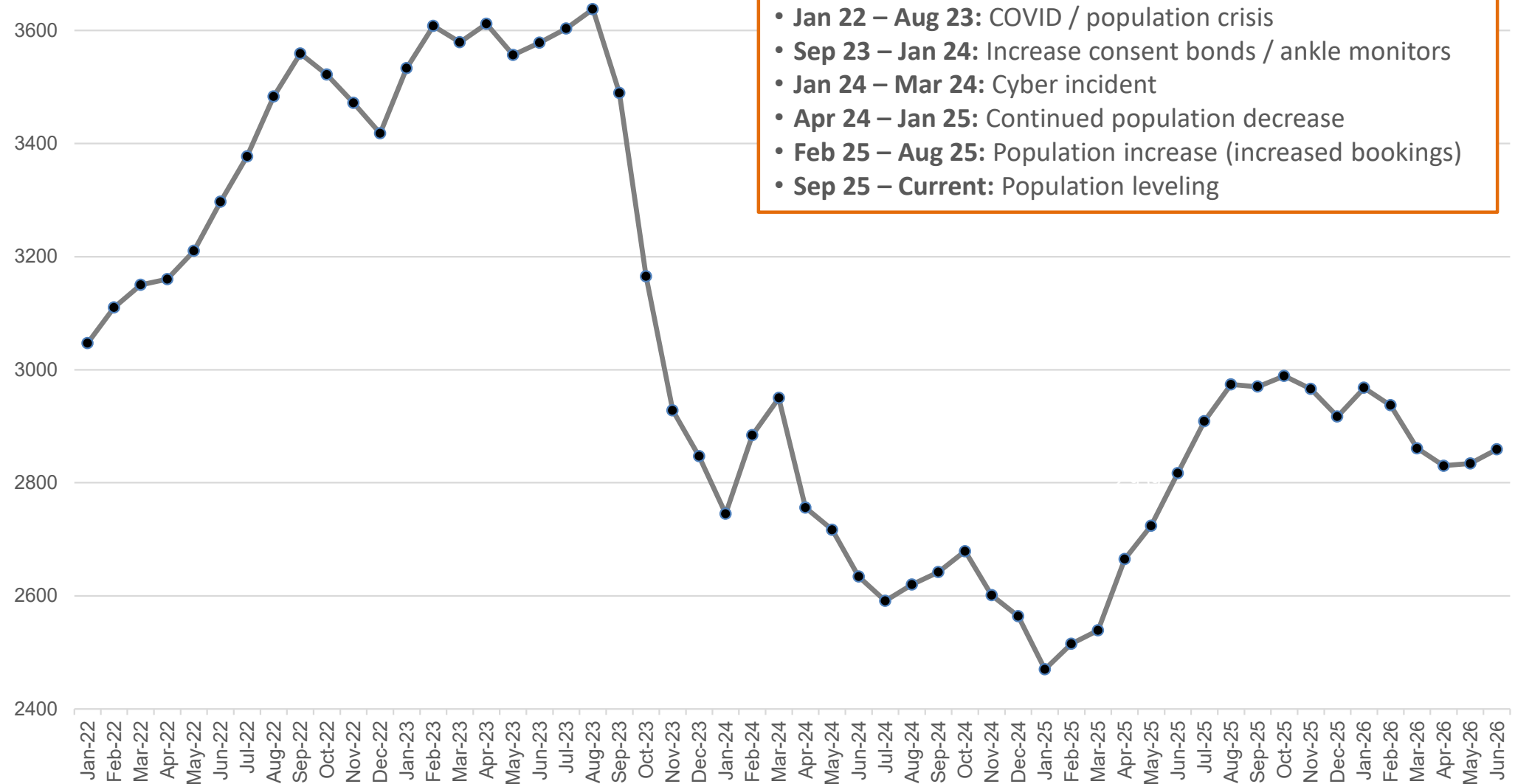
AVERAGE JAIL POPULATION - ALL FACILITIES

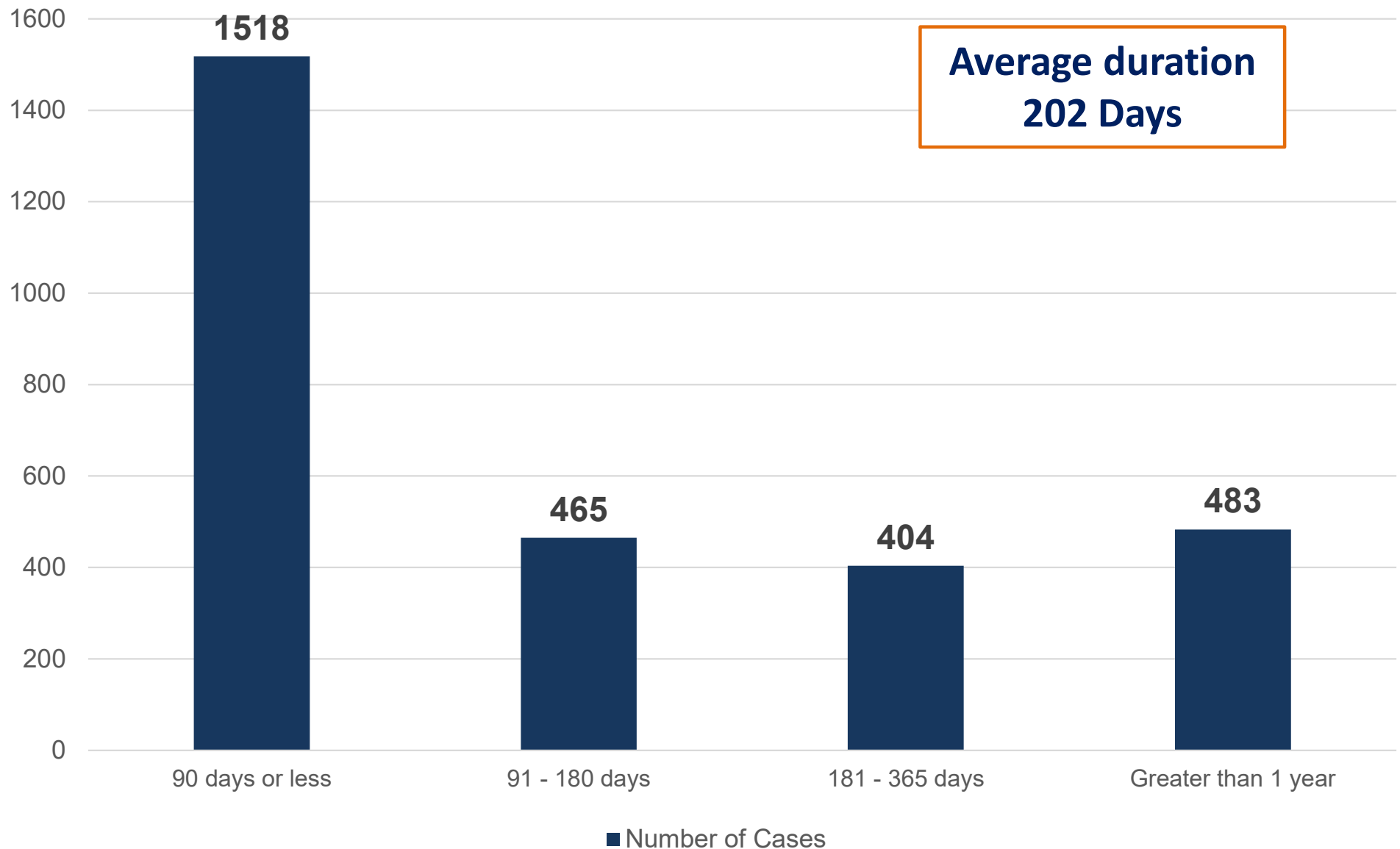
Trend Analysis

LENGTH OF STAY FOR CURRENTLY INCARCERATED INMATES IN JAIL

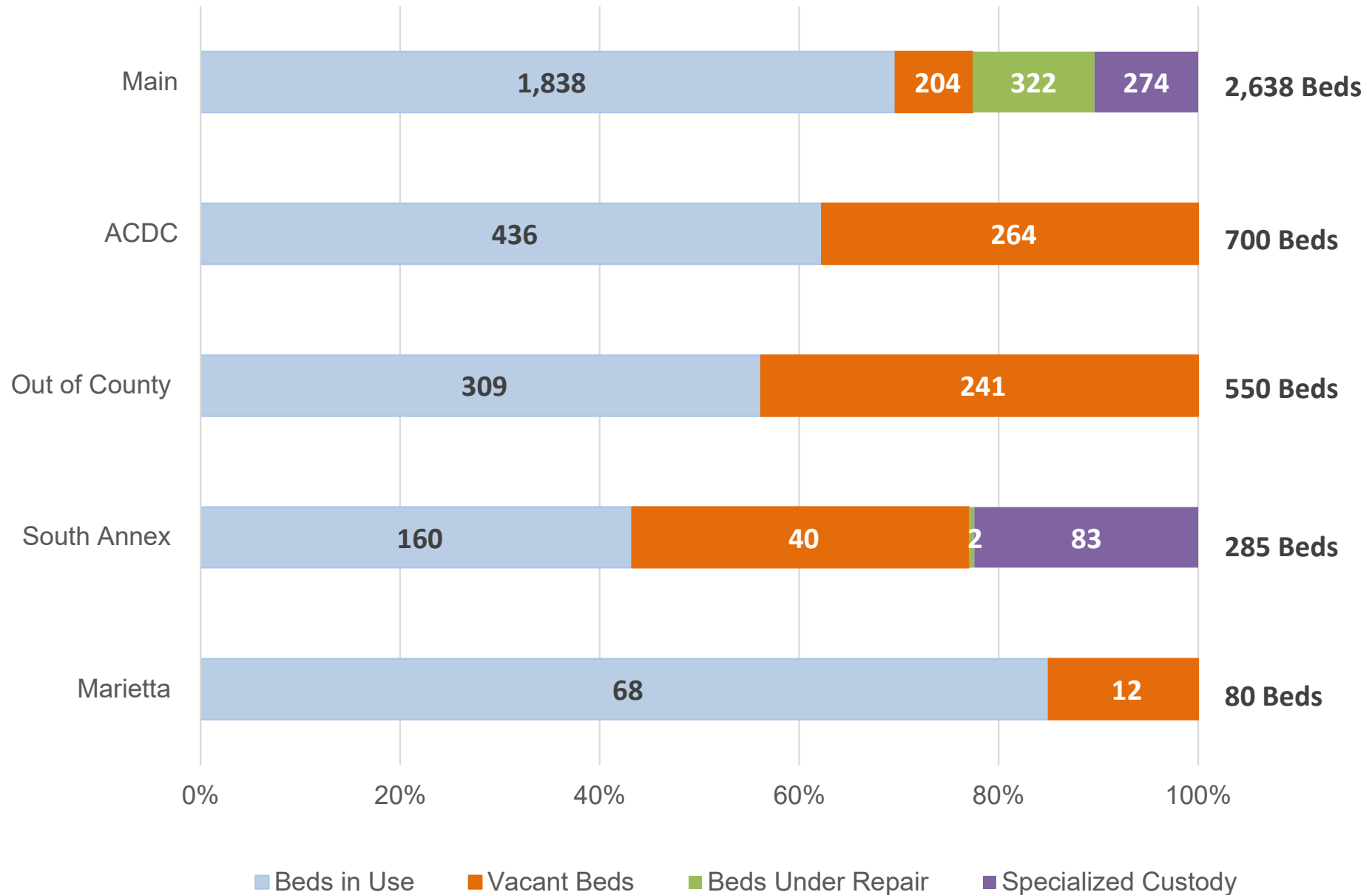

Specialized Custody: inmate classification, competency, discipline, protective custody



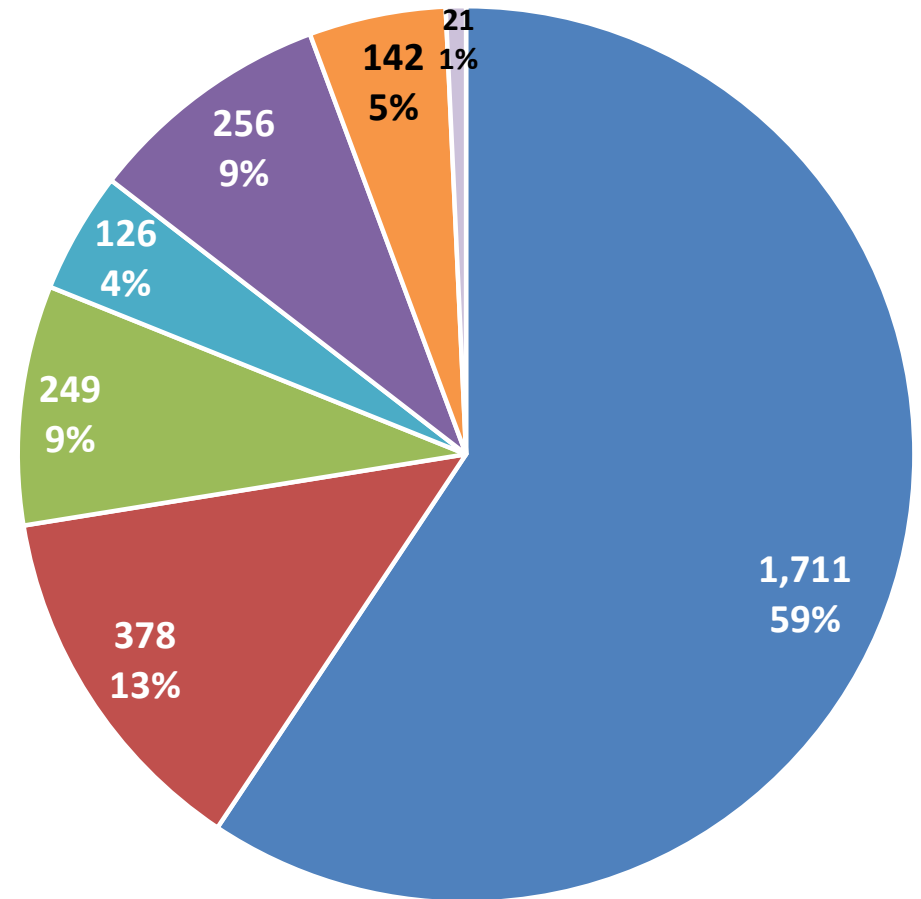

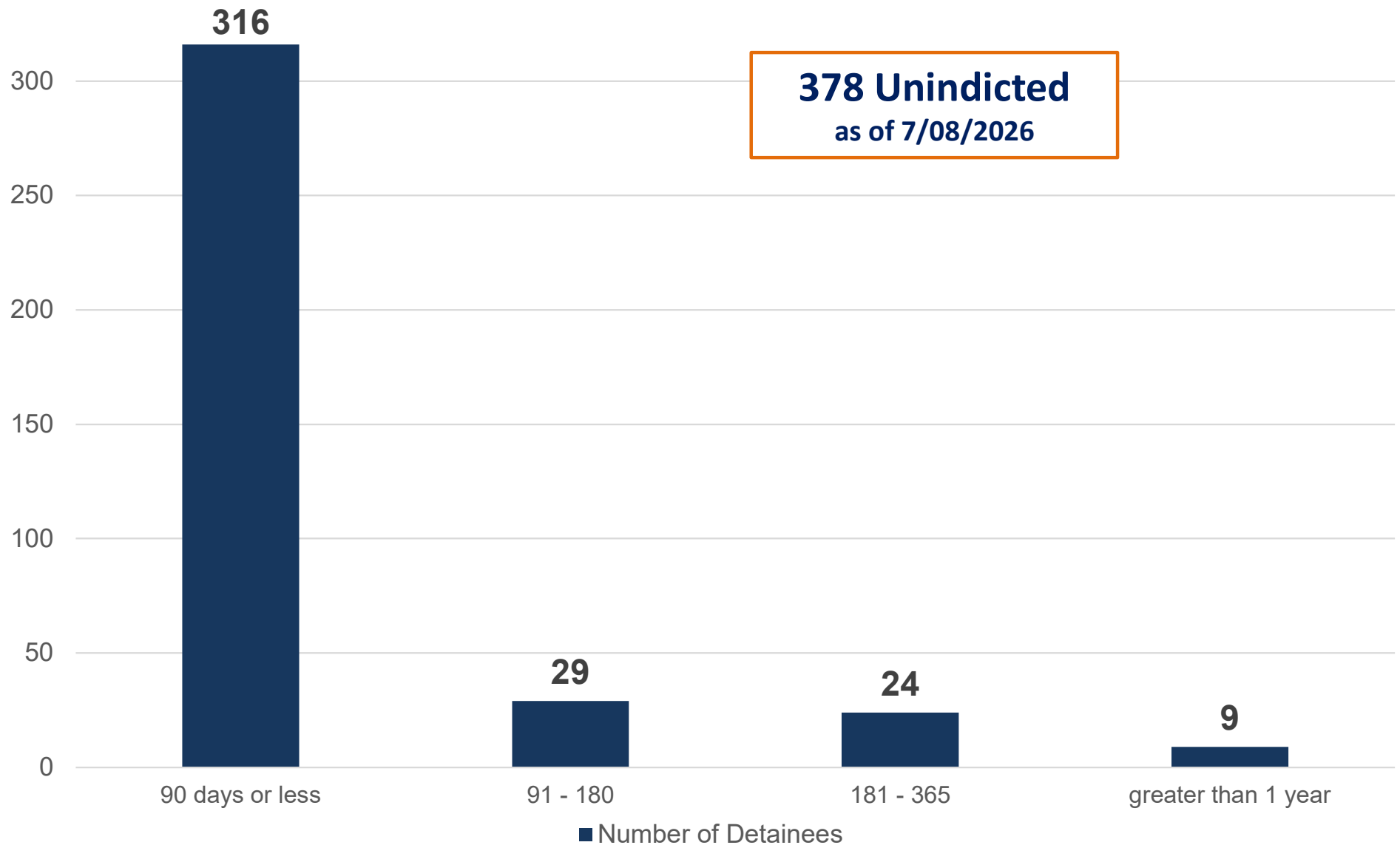

UNINDICTED JAIL POPULATION

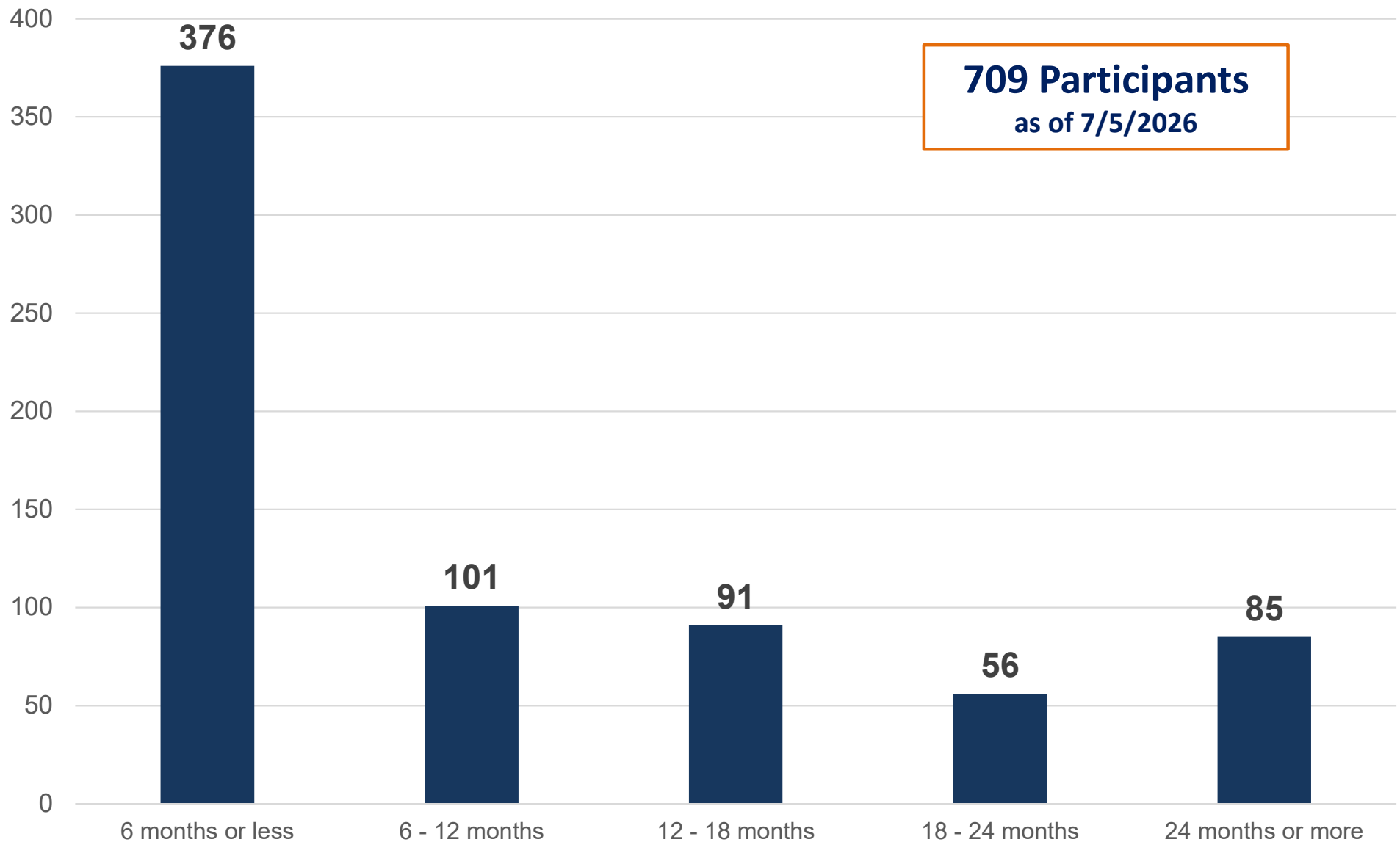
DAYS IN JAIL

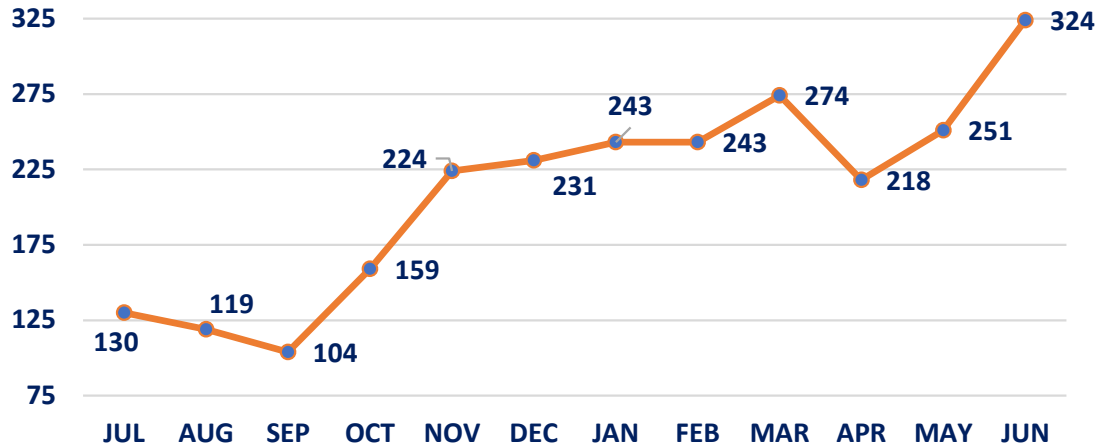

DIVERSIONS AND DISCHARGES AS OF 6/30/2026

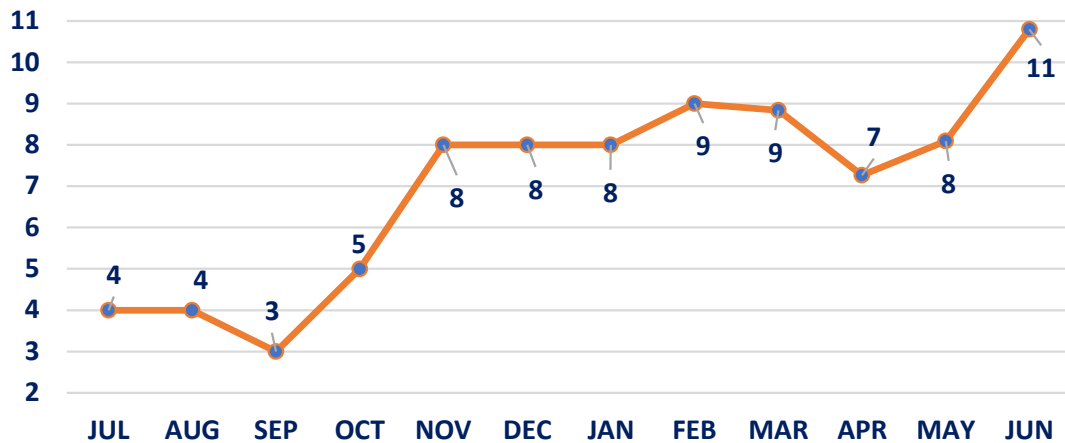

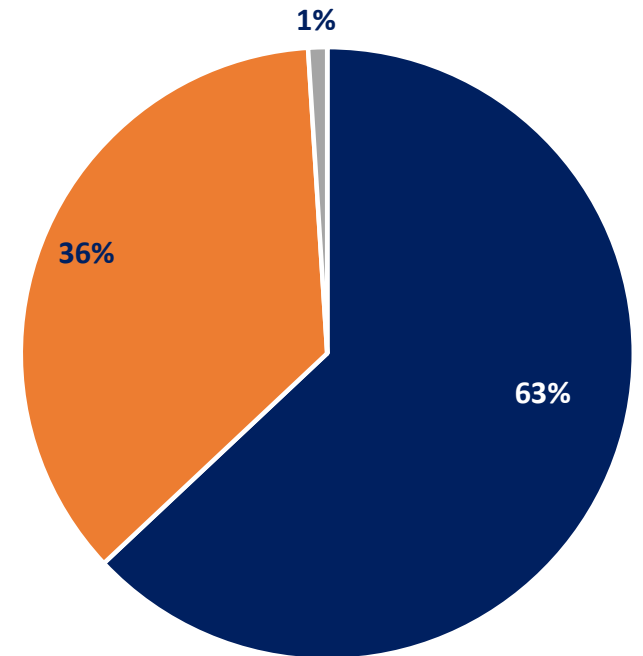
Rolling 12 Month Diversions



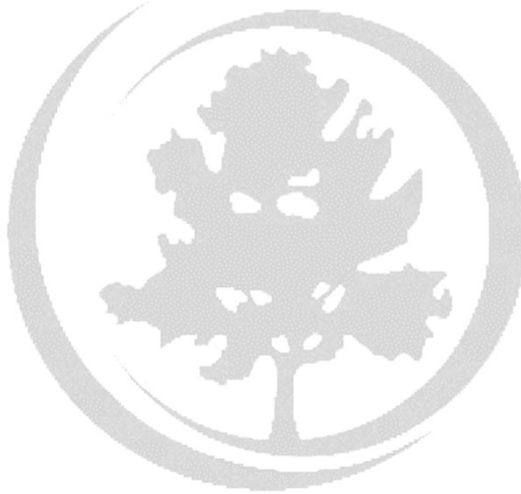
Rolling 12 Month Average Daily Census



June Discharges



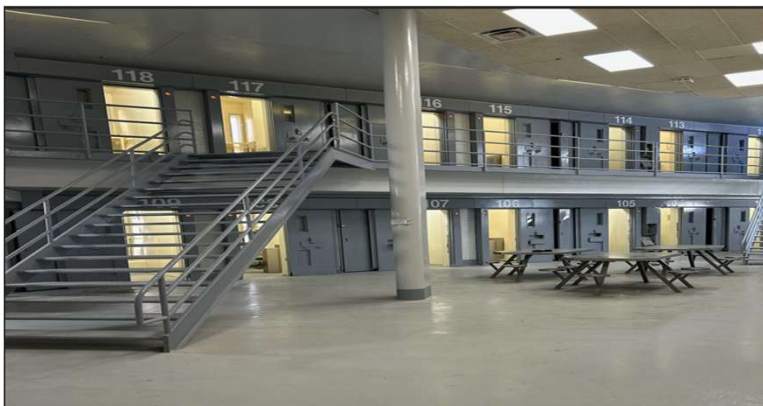
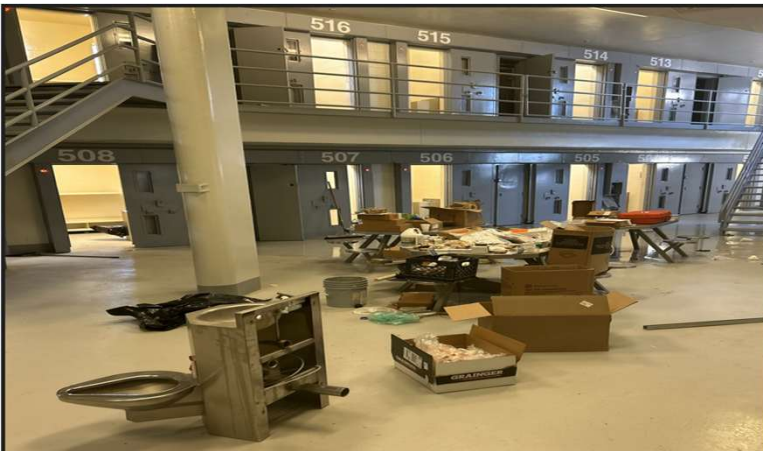

JAIL MAINTENANCE UPDATE

Jail Maintenance Blitz



- **11 of 13** housing units completed = **85%**
 - Final 2 units were initially slated for “phase 2 of blitz”. Enhanced jail maintenance precludes need for phase 2.
 - Classification concerns preclude use of 5 South for
- **7 North Zone 600:** Fire on 12/12/2025 requires major mechanical and aesthetic remediation. Smoke damaged zones (100-500) have been remediated.
- Upcoming blitz area: **6 South**
 - **No completion projection at this time**
 - Anticipated to begin in August based on fire remediation of 7 North

Jail Maintenance Performance

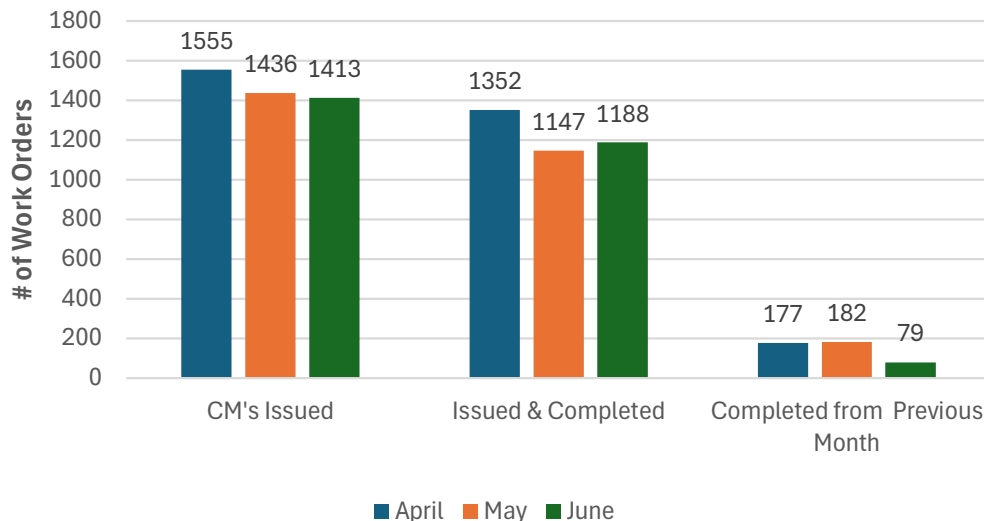
Thru 7/9/2026

- **Corrective Maintenance (June 2026)**
 - 1,188 of 1,413 issued & completed: **84%**
 - 79 June CM's completed in July = **90%**
 - 1,302 total CM work orders completed in June
 - 65% of new work orders due to vandalism
- **Preventive Maintenance (June 2026)**
 - 301 of 332 PM's scheduled & completed: **88%**
- **Open Work Orders > 30 days = 663**
 - Upcoming blitz areas: **344**
 - Blitz areas require units to be vacant

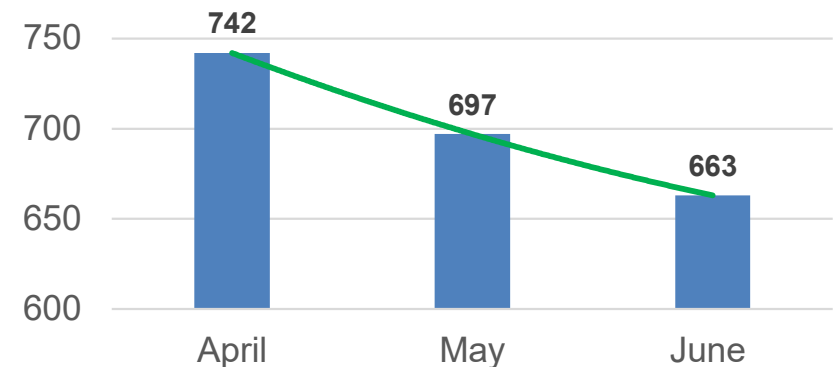


Fence Line Breach
