Phalon Alexander, professionally known as Jazze Pha, is a Super Producer, Singer, Songwriter, Rapper, and DJ who was influenced from a very young age by his parents, singer and songwriter Sydne Denece Hudson and James Alexander, founding member and bassist for the Bar-Kays; and



*WHEREAS,*

Jazze Pha met the late great MC Breed, who saw his potential and took him under his wing and introduced him to the Atlanta music scene; and



*WHEREAS,*

Jazze Pha formed a production and management partnership with *Noontime Music* which birthed his record label, *ShoNuff Records*; and



*WHEREAS,*

Jazze Pha's first superstar collaboration was with Atlanta native and multi-platinum recording artist, Ciara; he went on to produce Young Jeezy, Young Joc, T.I., Ludacris, Usher, Two Chainz, and several other chart topping artists; and



*WHEREAS,*

Jazze Pha is the first music producer to ink a 50 song deal with Cash Money Records, working alongside Mannie Fresh, Lil Wayne, Birdman, and Slim; he is one of the few producers who has worked with both Notorious B.I.G. and 2Pac; and



*WHEREAS,*

Jazze Pha's productions range from Mary J. Blige's *Just Fine*, Ayo and Taiyo *Rolex* which did over one billion streams, and ghetto anthems like *Sho Nuff* with Tela, 8Ball & MJG, to Gospel tunes with Snoop Dogg and Jevon Dewand, and the Trap Starz performing at the Stellar Awards alongside icons like Cece Winans and Kirk Franklin; these are just a few of many projects among the 170 million copies to his credit;
