

Call for Artists: Fulton County 3D Sculpture Commission

Project Overview: We are seeking talented Georgia-based artists to create a unique and original 3D sculpture that embodies the rich history and sense of place of Fulton County, Georgia, with a special emphasis on the region's civil rights history.
