A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE CONDUCTING A LOCAL RATE STUDY FOR 1 BASINS IMPACTING THE WATER SOUTH FULTON COUNTY: TO 2 DETERMINE IF ANY IMPROVEMENTS ARE NEEDED TO THE WATER AND 3 SEWER TREATMENT FACILITIES IN THE AREA; TO RATIFY ACTIONS 4 TAKEN BY THE STAFF; TO MANDATE THAT THE RESULTS OF THE STUDY 5 BE PRESENTED TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR REVIEW AND 6 TO DETERMINE WHETHER A RATE INCREASE IS NEEDED TO SUPPORT 7 ANY RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE STUDY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. 8 9

10 WHEREAS, counties in Georgia are delegated the authority to provide 11 sewer and water services in the Supplementary Powers provision of the Georgia 12 Constitution (Art. 9, § 2, ¶ III of the Georgia Constitution of 1983); and,

WHEREAS, Fulton County's authority to "prescribe, revise, and collect
rates, fees, tolls, or charges for the services..." is set out in O.C.G.A. § 36-82-62;
and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan North Georgia Water Planning District ("MNGWPD") recommends to local governments in its Wastewater and Water Management Plans that "...water rates should be based on a local rate study and designed to provide a sufficient revenue stream to support program costs and facility maintenance;" and,

21 WHEREAS, the Fulton County Public Works Department and the Fulton 22 County Finance Department, with the assistance of a professional consultant, desire 23 to conduct a local rate study to determine the short and long term needs for the 24 County's water and sewer system in the areas located in South Fulton County ("South 25 County System"); and

WHEREAS, a detailed analysis of the Fulton County Water and Sewer System ("System") was conducted in 2015 to identify comprehensive capital improvement projects needed for areas throughout the County for the purpose of providing adequate and cost-effective water and sewer services to its existing and future 30 customers for the foreseeable time horizon; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with this effort, the Public Works Department presented, and the Fulton County Board of Commissioners approved, a detailed list of capital improvements designated as the 2016 to 2025 Capital Improvement Program ("Program"), which were necessary to meet the System needs at the time; and

WHEREAS, mayors of cities in South Fulton County have expressed a desire to have a new local rate study performed which will address the short term and long term water and sewer needs of South Fulton County as a result of the growth in this area since the 2015 study was performed; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the current and future water and sewer needs of South Fulton County through 2026, and to sustain and improve the quality of health for its citizens, the County must determine if any capital improvement projects are needed, along with the proposed cost of the same, and the appropriate allocation of those costs to both existing and future customers; and

44 WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners recognizes the need 45 for a local rate study to be performed in order to identify capital improvement projects 46 in South Fulton County that should be initiated in order to continue to sustain and 47 enhance the South County System along with the quality of life for all its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes and approves initiating a local rate study for the South County System.

51 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the County Manager is directed to initiate 52 the study and report any recommendations to the Board of Commissioners at the first 53 available meeting immediately after the recommendations are finalized.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners shall review the

recommendations of the local rate study once they are presented to determine if a rate 55 increase is warranted to support any proposed new capital improvements to the South 56 Fulton System. 57

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any actions that the County Manager and 58 the staff have already undertaken in furtherance of this effort are hereby ratified and 59 approved. 60

61 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that every effort should be taken to contact the 62 mayors in South Fulton County and solicit their input into the process.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective when 63 adopted, and that all resolutions and provisions of the Code of Laws in conflict with this 64 Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict. 65
