Old Rucker Farm is operated by the City of Alpharetta Recreation and Parks Department as an organic farm, including a vegetable, fruit, and herb garden, a native pollinator garden, community garden plots, and an outdoor classroom; and



WHEREAS,

The work of Old Rucker Farm will evolve over time, striving to best serve and meet the needs of the entire community, integrating agriculture and sustainability throughout the city;
