Mission Agape began its mission in 2008 when several churches from Duluth’s Korean-American community partnered to help marginalized citizens in metro Atlanta and Fulton County; and



WHEREAS,

Mission Agape’s primary ministries are the Food Ministry, the Prison Ministry, the Coat Ministry, the Seoul Ministry Outreach, and the Peru Ministry Outreach; and



WHEREAS,

Mission Agape remains active during the recent COVID-19 pandemic and the restrictions that came with it, providing masks and hand sanitizer to core mission partners; the mission is eager to reinvigorate the homeless hot meal program and coats programs; and



WHEREAS,

with the future in mind, Mission Agape is looking forward to re-engaging its Ware State Prison program, and hopes to explore its Peru Outreach to the capitol city of Lima;
