## Carter Jones Report

- •Chain of Custody Issues: Throughout absentee ballot processing, there were frequent chain of custody issues, including ballots being transported in unsecured mail carts and inadequate managerial oversight.
- •Technological and Procedural Errors: Issues with equipment delivery, ballot processing, and inaccurate terminology usage led to confusion and operational inefficiencies.
- •Transparency and Monitoring: There were numerous concerns regarding transparency, including controversial decisions like bringing in ballots through back doors and issues with monitoring compliance.
- •Recount Challenges: Poor record-keeping and procedural errors during the recount process exacerbated challenges, including mixing ballots and technological failures.
- •Runoff Election Challenges: Communication issues with monitors, accuracy problems with data entry, and concerns over ballot security were highlighted during the runoff election.

## Carter Jones Report

- **Processing Timeliness:** While most applications were processed promptly, there were instances where ballots were delayed significantly, highlighting the need for improved efficiency.
- **Ballot Processing Issues:** During the general election, there were major organizational issues and chain of custody problems in handling absentee ballots, leading to delays and procedural errors.
- **Document Retention:** Adequate procedures observed at State Farm for securing ballots.
- Risk-Limiting Audit (RLA) and Recount: Managed RLA effectively but encountered significant delays and procedural errors during the recount.
