Request approval to increase spending authority - Department of Real Estate and Asset Management, RFP#15RFP98638K-JD, Comprehensive Operation and Preventive and Predictive Maintenance Services for Fulton County Jail in the amount of \$530,923 with Johnson Controls, Inc. (Atlanta, GA), to cover the cost for critical capital expenditures for the Fulton County Jail. Effective upon BOC approval.

Summary & Background

Scope of Work: This contract provides for management, supervision, labor, materials, supplies, spare parts, tools, equipment, scheduling and coordination, required for effective and economical operation, preventive maintenance, predictive maintenance, corrective/repair maintenance and approved work projects for twelve (12) facility grounds and building systems of the Fulton County Jail Complex.

The Facility Maintenance Contractor (FMC) will provide all managerial, administrative and technical functions for the effective and timely accomplishment of the technical requirements described below. The Scope of Work includes all, but not limited to, operation preventive and predictive maintenance and emergency services for the building and building systems in the facilities. The contractor shall be fully responsible for providing customer service, quality control and all other services.

Scope for Capital Projects:

This amendment is to increase spending authority to cover the cost for additional capital expenditures for projects for the Fulton County Jail.

1	Resurface Showers (50)	Original shower coating deteriorated and must be replaced. Showers rendered unusable. Lack of usable showers drastically impacts ability to provide constitutionally mandated showers for inmates. Existing coating deterioration creates environmental health hazard. Additionally, inmates are able to make weapons using the broken pieces of the old coating.	\$162,500
2	Replace Kitchen coolers and freezers	Replace 22 year old OEM equipment that maintenance vendor can no longer guarantee operation. Existing units have deteriorated flooring, inoperable compressors, and deteriorated seals and walls. Long-term storage of food items is infeasible.	\$189,965

Community Impact: None that the Department is aware of.

Department Recommendation: The Department of Real Estate and Asset Management recommends approval to increase spending authority to cover the cost for additional capital expenditures for critical projects for the Fulton County Jail through fiscal year 2018.

This request for increase in spending authority is to cover the additional expenses required in order to address critical system failures due to the age of equipment.

The Department is requesting an additional \$530,923 to ensure the projects will be completed by December 2018. These anticipated additional capital expenses will exceed the current spending authority of \$4,973,945 for FY2018. The current spending balance is \$7,300.

The approval of this increase in the amount of \$530,923 will covered anticipated capital expenditures and operational maintenance and repairs through December 2018.

Project Implications: Failure to approve this item will result in inability of the Sheriff's Office to comply with State of Georgia constitutional mandates related to inmate care and safety.

Community Issues/Concerns: None that the Department is aware of.

Department Issues/Concerns: If this authority increase is not approved, DREAM would not be able to maintain the facility as is necessary to ensure the operational continuity of jail operations. The

department does not have the internal resources necessary to facilitate the requisite work.

- 2. **COMPENSATION:** The services described under Scope of Work herein shall be

performed by Contractor for a total amount not to exceed \$530,923.00.

- 3. **LIABILITY OF COUNTY:** This Amendment No. 2 to Form of Contract shall not become binding on the County and the County shall incur no liability upon same until such agreement has been executed by the Chair to the Commission, attested to by the Clerk to the Commission and delivered to Contractor.
- 4. **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO FORM OF CONTRACT:** Except as modified by this Amendment No. 2 to Form of Contract, the Contract, and all Contract Documents, remain in full force and effect.

Johnson Controls, Inc. (JCI) has continued to perform at a good level throughout the review period. JCI continues to exhibit a high degree of technical expertise and all requested reports are submitted in a timely manner. JCl has complied with the contract specifications approximately 95% of the time. The only area of improvement with regards to specification compliance is the addition of new facility capital equipment to the computerized maintenance management system database and ensuring all

preventive maintenance tasks recommended by manufacturers are followed.
