The Drifters entertained fans around the world until 2015 and are members of the Vocal Group Hall of Fame, the Songwriters Hall of Fame, the Rhythm & Blues Hall of Fame, and the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame; the group is among the 100 Greatest Artists of All Time by Rolling Stone magazine; and

while traveling all over the world, Bennie founded Class and Style Limousine Service, later becoming A-National Limousine Service Inc., one of the largest ground transportation companies in the Southeastern United States; and

Bennie leaves to cherish his memory his wife, Mrs. Linda Anderson, his sons: Michum, Darrell, Antonio, Grant, and D'Shaun, and his grandchildren, greatgrandchildren, and one great-great grandchild;
