DJ Funky became a featured DJ and radio personality on Jermaine Dupri's *So So Def Radio* on Atlanta's V-103FM station, where he interviewed the biggest celebrities in the entertainment industry; and

DJ Funky is one of the founding members of the Coalition DJs, playing an instrumental role in promoting and introducing new music to many of Atlanta's entertainment venues; chart topping rap artists including 2Chainz, Future, and Migos have all credited DJ Funky and the Coalition DJs with transforming their tracks into hits; and

in August 2013, DJ Funky and the Coalition DJs were featured in a Wall Street Journal article highlighting their significant impact on the music industry; and

DJ Funky collaborates with a diverse range of independent and major artists alongside various production houses, consistently releasing fresh projects that resonate with audiences; he also served as the program director for WorldStar Hit Radio, further showcasing his versatility and expertise;
