WHEREAS,

Black Health Matters embraces our heritage by recognizing the impact of Black innovators in health and encourages the community to reflect on the profound significance of understanding our genetic health and family history within the context of our broader history; and



WHEREAS,

among the conditions that might impact us include asthma, allergies, ADHD, bipolar disorders, cancer, coronary artery disease, Cystic Fibrosis, depression, diabetes, Down Syndrome, eczema, glaucoma, Huntington's Disease, hypertension, kidney disease, lupus, psoriasis, sarcoidosis, Sickle Cell Disease, and vitiligo; and

the Black Health Matters 2024 Winter Health Summit & Expo will be held in Atlanta, Georgia on March 2, 2024, offering free biometric screenings and several testing options to include breast exams, full panel blood screening, STD testing, and several others; and
