27	Section 1. ELECTION APPOINTMENT.
28 29	(A) The City Clerk is hereby appointed to act as the election superintendent, qualifying officer, and local filing officer for the 2025 General Election.
30 31 32	(B) The administrative office of the City of South Fulton, Georgia is hereby declared to be the office of the Election Superintendent for the purpose of candidates qualifying for the offices open for election as provided below.

Section 8. LAST DAY FOR A REGISTRAR TO ISSUE ABSENTEE BALLOTS

The last day for a registrar to issue absentee ballots for the 2025 November General Election shall be Friday, October 24, 2025. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)

<u>Section 9.</u> It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that: (a) All sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Resolution are or were, upon their enactment, believed by the City Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.

- (b) To the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution. No section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.
- (c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Resolution shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the City Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of the Resolution.
- <u>Section 10.</u> The City Attorney and City Clerk are authorized to make non-substantive editing and renumbering revisions to this Resolution for proofing, codification, and supplementation purposes. The final version of all resolutions shall be filed with the City Clerk.
- <u>Section 11.</u> The effective date of this Resolution shall be one week from the date of adoption, unless provided otherwise by the City Charter or state and/or federal law.
