Mary received Christ as a child and was an active member of Allen Temple A.M.E Church where she participated in the food bank distribution, leadership role with Girl Scouts of America, 'Just us Seniors' travel group, Cheerful Doorkeepers Usher Board, Stewardess Board Leader, Women's Missionary Society, Church Beautification Committee, and Class Leader Council where she serviced as President; Mary was also a member of Chi Mu Epsilon and Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc. Eta Sigma Chapter; and

Mary married her husband of 58 years, Harold Lyons, on September 30, 1963 at Calvary Hills Baptist Church and their union was blessed with three daughters: Detoncia, Pamela, and Raika; she was also the proud grandmother of three grandchildren: Kevin, Keinan, and Khristopher, and greatgrandmother of two great grandchildren: Kevin and Korina;
