1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	A RESOLUTION BY THE FULTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS APPROVING THE FORM CONTRACT, ENTITLED "MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR THERAPY ANIMAL PROGRAMMING WITHIN THE FULTON COUNTY LIBRARY SYSTEM" FOR USE IN THE FULTON COUNTY LIBRARY SYSTEM THERAPY ANIMAL PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE SUCH FORM MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENTS AND RELATED DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO APPROVE THE FORM MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AS TO FORM AND TO MAKE CHANGES THEREOF PRIOR TO EXECUTION; AND FOR OTHER RELATED PURPOSES.
11 12	WHEREAS, Fulton County, Georgia is authorized to engage in and expend funds
13	for community development programs and activities; and
14	WHEREAS, Fulton County recognizes that there are benefits to having citizens
15	who are healthy, happy, and engaged in their community; and
16	WHEREAS, the Fulton County Library System is established under O.C.G.A. § 20-
17	5-40 and Fulton County Code ("FCC") Chapter 26 in order to promote the establishment
18	of public library service throughout the state; and
19	WHEREAS, the Fulton County Library System, in its constitution, states that it
20	"serves as a cultural and intellectual center that enriches the community and empowers
21	all residents with essential tools for lifelong learning."
22	WHEREAS, the Fulton County Library System's Therapy Pet Program is designed
23	to assist young library patrons to encourage young, special needs, English as a Second
24	Language learners, or limited readers to enjoy the process of reading aloud without a
25	critical audience; and
26	WHEREAS, the Fulton County Library System's Therapy Pet Program provides
27	an opportunity for younger readers to be paired with dogs, cats, and other small,

domesticated animals specially trained to interact with youth; and

WHEREAS, providing therapy pets as an audience has been shown to reduce the anxiety in young and learning readers; and

WHEREAS, through the Fulton County Library System's Therapy Pet Program, Fulton County helps readers who otherwise may feel uncomfortable reading aloud, but with the help of an impartial therapy pet, can learn to excel as a reader; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fulton County Library System's Therapy Pet Program is contingent upon the participation of contractors which train therapy pets to safely interface with program participants; and

**WHEREAS**, there are a number of organizations made up entirely of volunteers or with non-profit or other small business status that provide therapy pet services; and

WHEREAS, the particular organizations available to provide therapy pet programming throughout the county may change from time-to-time due to the volunteer nature of the work; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds it necessary to develop a form Memorandum of Agreement in which Fulton County will contract with independent contractors capable of providing pet therapy programs and who meets certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreements with the participating contractors are necessary to ensure safety and health protections for all involved, to ensure all contractors are providing training and certification of animals for participation in the program, and to ensure liability protections for the county; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners further finds that it is in the best interest of the County to utilize a standard form contract with eligible contractors, entitled,

- 1 "MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR THERAPY PET PROGRAMMING WITHIN
- 2 THE FULTON COUNTY LIBRARY SYSTEM," in order to ensure flexibility with the
- 3 contractors selected and the locations where the Program will be provided, and to ensure
- 4 that the therapy animals best serve the interest of its citizens that may best benefit from
- 5 the program; and
- 6 **WHEREAS**, for purposes of efficiency and expediency in County operations, the
- 7 Board of Commissioners deems it to be in the best interest of the County to authorize the
- 8 County Manager or his designee to execute these form Memorandum of Agreements and
- 9 related documents, when recommended by the Fulton County Library System.
- 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of
- 11 Commissioners hereby approves the attached form contract entitled "MEMORANDUM"
- 12 OF AGREEMENT FOR THERAPY PET PROGRAMMING WITHIN THE FULTON
- 13 COUNTY LIBRARY SYSTEM," in substantially the form attached here to Attachment 1,
- 14 for use in the Fulton County Library System's Therapy Pet Program.
- 15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the County Manager or his designee is
- delegated the authority to authorize, complete, and execute the form Memorandum of
- 17 Agreement.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Attorney is hereby authorized to
- 19 approve the Form Memorandum of Agreement and related documents as to form and to
- 20 make necessary modifications thereto in order to protect the interest of Fulton County,
- 21 prior to execution by the County Manager or his designee.

1	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon execution of a Form Memorandum of
2	Agreement by the County Manager, such Memorandum of Agreement shall be spread on
3	the minutes of the Board of Commissioners at a subsequent meeting.
4	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective upon its
5	adoption, and that all prior actions inconsistent with this Resolution and parts of
6	resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
