**WHEREAS,** In the last 10 years, the Atlanta Women's Foundation, using its collective impact model, has funded nonprofits and programs offering access to services to over 64,000 women and girls; and



**WHEREAS.** The Atlanta Women's Foundation spearheads groundbreaking research to uncover the barriers women and girls face and brings together professional women and organizations to create strategies and amplify solutions; and



WHEREAS, The Atlanta Women's Foundation's recent \$2.3 million investment provided more than 25,000 women access to workforce training, business development support, childcare, employment opportunities, and other services for attaining economic stability;



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Fulton County Board of Commissioners recognizes the impactful work of the Atlanta Women's Foundation, and, in honor of International Women's Day, does hereby proclaim Saturday, March 8, 2025, as "ATLANTA WOMEN'S FOUNDATION APPRECIATION DAY" in Fulton County, Georgia.
