DJ Jelly has been a key factor in breaking local Atlanta artists including OutKast, Lil Jon, T.I., Jeezy, DJ UNK, Travis Porter, and Wakafloka, among many others; and

DJ Jelly has won numerous awards for his artistry, including Justo's Mixtape "Dirty South DJ of the Year", TjsDJ's "Tastemakers Award", SEA's "Best Blend Tape" and SEA's "Dirty South DJ of the Year, among many others;
