404 Chucq was born and raised on the West Side of Atlanta, and is widely known as “The Ear of the Street”; his stage name reflects his role as a translator who moves between neighborhoods, boardrooms, and everyday people, bringing real stories wherever he goes; and



WHEREAS,

404 Chucq was raised in the church by his evangelist mother and began performing in a group at an early age; he began writing lyrics during late-night church shut-ins; and



WHEREAS,

404 Chucq’s musical awakening came while absorbing the sounds of OutKast, Eightball & MJG, Scarface, and Kool G Rap—artists whose storytelling depth showed him that hip hop could be both personal and powerful; and



WHEREAS,

404 Chucq’s work is heavily influenced by icons including Jay-Z, Andre 3000, Nipsey Hussle, D’Angelo, and Bankroll Fresh—each contributing something distinct to his creative DNA, from sharp simplicity and Southern lyricism to emotional depth, entrepreneurial mindset, and unapologetic authenticity; and

much of his catalog is autobiographical, reflecting a life observed closely and told honestly; his latest project, *Seen It All*, reflects both reflection and ambition—a statement that his story is still unfolding;
