Antwan Andre Patton, professionally known as Big Boi, is a native Georgian born in Savannah, later relocating to Atlanta and graduated from Tri-Cities High School where his iconic music career began and secured his legacy as one of the pioneers of Southern Hip Hop; and

Big Boi's career as one half of the award-winning duo, OutKast, began in 1992 and went on to produce six studio albums and six BET Awards, four American Music Awards, three Soul Train Awards, and seven Grammy awards, becoming the first and only hip-hop artist in history to win the Grammy for Album of the Year in 2003; and



WHEREAS,

Big Boi has also enjoyed a solo career, releasing three studio albums, and has earned success as a songwriter, record producer, actor and philanthropist; he also performed at the Super Bowl LIII halftime show on February 3, 2019 in Atlanta at the Mercedes Benz Stadium; and



WHEREAS,

Big Boi has two solo singles, *Kryptonite* and *All Night*, that are both Certified Gold by the Recording Industry

Association of America(RIAA), and Outkast's Speakerboxx/The Love Below is RIAA Certified Diamond;

Big Boi has used his platform to give back to his beloved hometown, and launched the Big Kidz Foundation, a nonprofit organization that enriches the lives of youth in

Atlanta; and

Big Boi's greatest achievement above all of his awards and accolades is his family; he is the proud father of two sons,

one daughter, and he has one grandson;
