Pastor Sonya E. Williams is a graduate of Eastern Tennessee State University and received her ministerial training at the Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta, Georgia; and



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WHEREAS,

Pastor Williams' ministerial journey spans over 27 years, beginning when she was called to minister to marginalized and disenfranchised communities; she is ordained by the United Church of Christ, Southeast Conference, and The Fellowship of Affirming Ministries; and



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WHEREAS,

in 2008, Pastor Williams founded Real Inspiration Ministries Fellowship UCC, formerly Restoration Inclusive Ministries where she serves as Lead Shepherd; and



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WHEREAS,

Pastor Williams is the founder of "Love Thy Children", an organization committed to creating a society where every child can develop, learn, and thrive in an environment appreciative of diversity, without violence, without fear, and without limitations; and



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WHEREAS,

Pastor Williams is also the founder of the "Feed My Sheep" Outreach Ministry, which feeds over 500 food and housing insecure citizens each month; she also served as missionary to Haiti and hosts a "Change for Change" campaign for the Los Memorias Hospital and Hospice in Tijuana, Mexico, which houses people living with AIDS and HIV; and

Pastor Williams is a proud member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. and is married to First Lady Regina Franklin; they are the proud parents of a daughter, Dashley, and grandparents of one granddaughter, Da'Kodah;
