



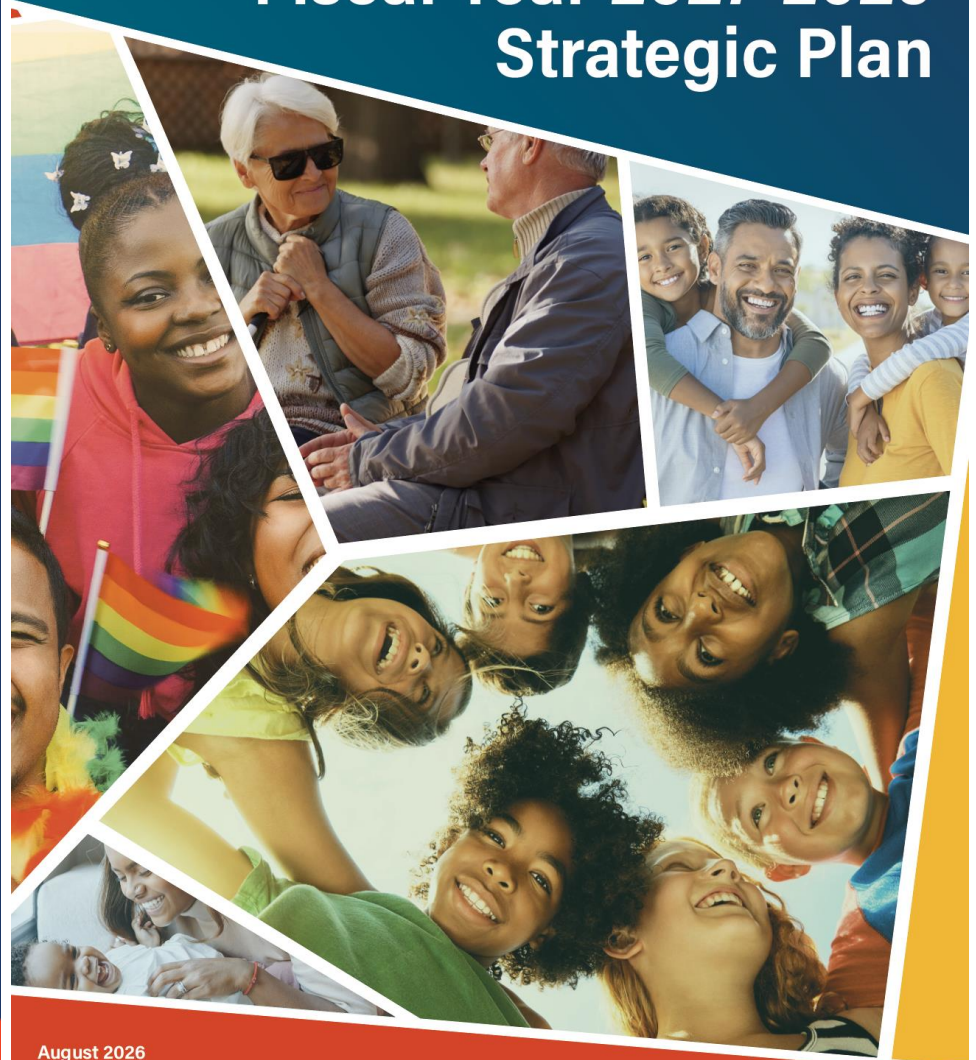

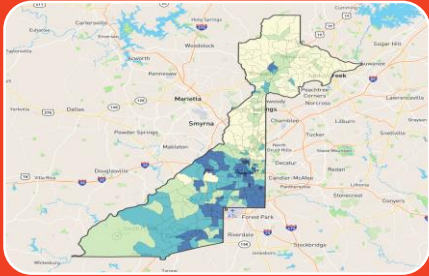

Roadmap Ahead



Community Health Assessment (CHA)

- Tells us what's going on in the County
- Informed by Board of Health + Dept Public Health, community groups, healthcare, non-profits, schools, etc.
- ETA: August (lead: Georgia Health Policy Center)



Community Health Implementation Plan (CHIP)

- Tells us what is needed to address what is going on in the County
- Informed by community groups, healthcare, schools, etc.
- ETA: August (lead: Georgia Health Policy Center)



Strategic Plans

- Tells us how the Board of Health, County, hospitals, partners, etc will operationalize the CHIP priorities in Fulton County
- ETA for Board of Health: finished; will be updated to reflect CHIP recommendations

Potential CHIP Priorities

Disease Prevention, Early Detection, & Control

1. Chronic Disease
 - Cardio/Cerebro-vascular
 - Cancer
2. Mental and Behavioral Health
 - Substance Misuse Prevention & Treatment
 - Injury & Harm Reduction
3. Infectious Disease
 - HIV
 - Other Sexually Transmitted Infections

Health Promotions & Vital Conditions

1. Easy & Affordable Access to Care
 - Workforce
2. Basic Needs for Health (Wellbeing) & Safety
 - Food Security
3. Housing Stability



Focus strategies on communities and populations with **low health equity** and **high outcome disparities** –

- Women (maternal), Infants, Children
- Teens and Seniors
- Low SES groups and neighborhoods

More local data/information gathering and dissemination



FCBOH in the Community

North Fulton Clinic Opening

- New North Fulton Regional Health Center opens in Alpharetta



FIFA World Cup Food Vendor Inspections

- Promoted food safety and inspections for Atlanta's World Cup visitors from all over the globe.



New Environmental Health Fee Schedule

- EH reviewed fees to ensure they are fair, consistent, and reflect actual costs
- Some fees added to services previously without them to account for resources required
- Others lowered to align with charges in other Georgia jurisdictions



Infectious Disease Response

- Measles, Cyclosporiasis, & STI cases investigated
- Tuberculosis exposure in North Fulton prompts disease testing efforts



MEASLES UPDATE

The Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH) has confirmed measles in three members of a metro Atlanta family.

The family was not vaccinated and traveled internationally. While they were not infectious during travel, DPH is working to identify people who may have been exposed to measles through contact with these individuals once they returned home and developed symptoms.

- Benefits:
 - Aligns work with national measures focusing on core public health capabilities, health disparities, and quality improvement
 - Promotes continuous performance improvement and stronger agency infrastructure
 - Builds greater public trust and proves value to community stakeholders and lawmakers
