

1 **A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE TASK FORCE ON**
2 **ELECTIONS WITHIN FULTON COUNTY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

4 **WHEREAS**, There are over Eight Hundred Thousand registered voters in Fulton
5 County, Georgia; and

6 **WHEREAS**, During the June 9, 2020 election there were widespread issues with
7 the voting process in Fulton County; including Power issues with voting equipment, long
8 lines at polling places, delayed openings at several polling places, voter confusion with
9 respect to precinct locations, and an influx of voters who were not able to vote via
10 absentee ballots; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in response to the issues with voting within Fulton County during the
12 June 9, 2020 election, the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County created a task force
13 on elections in Agenda Item 20-0442 of the June 17, 2020 Recess Meeting; and

14 **WHEREAS**, upon creation of this task force, each Commissioner was to appoint
15 three (3) members to make up the membership of the task force; and

16 **WHEREAS**, The Board of Commissioners of Fulton County desires to improve the
17 operation of the task force and continue to foster a more efficient voting process in Fulton
18 County by reducing the number of appointees to the task force.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Fulton County Board of
20 Commissioners' Task Force on Elections shall have the following members: Each
21 Commissioner shall appoint two (2) members. Such appointees shall be residents and
22 electors of Fulton County, and preferably have backgrounds in elections or be otherwise
23 qualified to serve as Board members. Initial member appointees shall serve until the task
24 force sunsets on December 31, 2021; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That once the members of the Fulton County Board of Commissioners' Task Force on Elections have been appointed, they shall elect one among them to serve as Chair of the task force. The Chair shall convene the meetings of the task force.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption, and that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
