RESOLUTION BY THE FULTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS IN ACCEPTANCE OF THE "AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN" SUPPORT AND CORONAVIRUS RELIEF LAW: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Act of 2021" ("Act") with broad bipartisan public support, and the President of the United States signed the bill into law on Thursday, March 11, 2021; and WHEREAS, this legislation infuses \$1.9 trillion in the U.S. economy to aid and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has passed the "American Rescue Plan

assist all Americans, and especially those who have been adversely impacted by the Coronavirus pandemic; and

WHEREAS, metropolitan cities, municipalities and counties will share \$130.2 billion in direct allocations from the Rescue Plan's Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, based upon their respective populations; and

WHEREAS, the Act has prescribed that funds distributed to the aforementioned jurisdictions shall be used (but not solely limited) to: (1) respond to or mitigate the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 emergency or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or aid to impacted industries such as tourism, travel, and hospitality; (2) provide government services; (3) make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure; 4) Respond to workers performing essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency by providing premium pay to eligible workers of the county that are performing such essential work, or by providing grants to eligible employers that have eligible workers who perform essential work; and (5) other relief activities, projects, services and programs; and

WHEREAS, analyses indicate that Fulton County's share of the Local Fiscal Recovery Fund is estimated at \$206 million, of which under the Act, half of that amount is to be disbursed to Fulton County on or before May 11, 2021, and the second half no earlier than 12 months after the first payment; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County residents and stakeholders have been impacted by the Coronavirus pandemic, including small business shuttering; renters being evicted; homeowners forced into foreclosure; families going hungry; government and other essential employees working under stress to keep others safe and well; and

WHEREAS, members of the Board of Commissioners, in their role as leaders of Fulton County and stewards of the taxpayers' and citizens' dollars are concerned about the health, safety and welfare of Fulton's residents: from Bankhead to Buckhead; from Alpharetta to Palmetto and every community in between; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has heard the cry and concern of many residents and must act upon their requests for support and assistance to help the local economy recover.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County on behalf of its more than one million residents, enthusiastically supports

and accepts the "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021" and any and all proceeds allocated to Fulton County, Georgia; derived from the Act.

BE IT RESOLVED, that Fulton County shall prioritize, utilize and set aside part of any federal Rescue funds for: (1) providing home-mortgage assistance to in-need homeowners; (2) premium pay increase for all full- and part-time County employees; (3) financial assistance to in-need small businesses with 30 or less employees; (4) youthand-young-adult jobs programs; and (5) the arts community in Fulton County including programs and services; "(6) Health Response, Operational Stability and Community Needs as identified by the County Manager's Presentation on March 17, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Board of Commissioners hereby directs the County Manager and the appropriate County staff to establish a utilization and distribution plan consistent with the intent of this Resolution, and in conformance with the rules and guidelines evinced in the Act, and other such rules promulgated by the U.S. Department of the Treasury and other federal agencies with oversight and compliance of the Rescue Plan's Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, and that the County Manager report back with the said plan within 30 days for action by the Board of Commissioners.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
