Income Self Attestation & Cost Share Determination (Agenda Item No. 24-0311)

- The Department of Senior Services sought the attestation information from over 7,000 registered senior riders.
- 3,749 seniors have provided their attestation information
- We have determined that 3,250 will pay \$1 and 499 will pay \$4.

October Trip Data

Active Riders: 2,105

- 1,875 paid \$1
- 230 paid \$4
- *Riders took an average of 5 trips in October

Recommendation based on BOC Action 2024 Average Ridership

2024 Ridership Average: 2,250

New Assumptions:

- 8 trips per month at \$1 cost share
- Will continue to monitor ridership, trips and budgetary impact, and report changes quarterly.

Based on current ridership, budget will hold at \$4.7M
