Booker T. Washington High School and continued his education at Florida A&M University and earned his Bachelor's degree in Instrumental Music; he later earned his Master's, Ed.S., and Doctorate degrees in Administration and Supervision at Atlanta University(now known as Clark Atlanta University); and



WHEREAS, Dr. Jordan began his career at Washington High School as director of both the concert and marching bands; he also served as assistant director of bands at Clark College, assistant principal at Briarcliff High School, assistant and head principal at Henderson High School in DeKalb County, and administrator of the Department of Student Relations for DeKalb County Schools, retiring in 2001;

Dr. Jordan received many honors and awards during his career, including two Kiwanis Club of Atlanta Star Teacher Awards, Atlanta Police Department Community Service Award, DeKalb School Administrators Spotlight Award, Area IX Principal of the Year, and the Honorary Life Membership in the DeKalb PTA Council; and

Dr. Jordan was one of the founders of the Metropolitan Atlanta Community Band, President of the DeKalb Administrators Association, DeKalb Association of Secondary School Principals, a member of the Kappa Kappa Psi National Honorary Band Fraternity, the Phi Beta Mu Bandmasters Fraternity, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, the Northlake Rotary Club, and Jackson Memorial Baptist Church in Atlanta;
