WHEREAS, Puneeth Satya Sreerama is a senior at Innovation Academy where he is Vice President of Student Volunteers, and a member of the Quiz Bowl where he ranked Top 40 in US History Bee, Top 40 in Political Science Bee, and 3rd Place in History Bee Regionals; and



WHEREAS, Puneeth has excelled in many areas of scouting, with achievements including Patrol Leader, Assistant Patrol Leader, Troop Guide, Instructor, Quartermaster, Messengers of Peace Award recipient, National Youth Leadership Training, President's Volunteer Award recipient, and Dharma Award recipient; and



WHEREAS, Puneeth has satisfied the strenuous requirements necessary to attain the rank of Eagle Scout, which include the design and construction of four two-person benches with armrests designed specifically for elderly accessibility, two six-foot picnic tables, and two signboards to guide visitors to place their shoes in the designated shoe storage areas for the Sri Hanuman Mandir in Alpharetta; and



WHEREAS, Puneeth will be recognized by friends, family and fellow Scouts for his attainment of the rank of Eagle Scout during a Court of Honor Ceremony on Saturday, May 16, 2026 at Johns Creek Presbyterian Church;
