

WHEREAS,

the Atlanta-Fulton Public Library System will acknowledge 2,008 volunteers, 150 volunteers who donated over 100 hours in 2013, including 60 who volunteered over 200 hours at their annual volunteer recognition program; and



WHEREAS,

twenty-four Friends of the Library groups provided significant support by contributing volunteer services and funds to enhance the Atlanta-Fulton Public Library System and are celebrated next week during National Friends of the Library Week; and



WHEREAS,

library volunteers have given unselfishly of their time and talents to the Atlanta-Fulton Public Library System, donating 67,645 hours in 2013, providing services worth \$1,525,407.15;
