Request approval of lowest responsible bidder - Department of Real Estate and Asset Management, Bid#19ITB654321K-JAJ, Fulton County Government Center Complex Tower and Public Safety Buildings Domestic Water Piping Replacement- Phase II in the amount of \$557,370 with J Squared Plumbing Co., Inc. (Decatur, GA), to provide domestic water piping replacement at the Fulton County Government Center Complex Tower and Public Safety Buildings, which this is a continuation of the water main replacement project that was started in Phase I. Effective for a period of 180 calendar days upon issuance of the Notice to Proceed.

Summary & Background

Scope of Work: This contract furnishes all materials, labor, tools, equipment and appurtenances necessary for the Domestic Water Piping Replacement – Phase II Project in the Fulton County Government Center Complex Tower and Public Safety Buildings located at 141 Pryor Street, SW, Atlanta, Georgia 30303.

The Scope of Work includes, but are not limited to:

- Demolition
- Debris removal
- Remove and replace approximately 920 lineal feet of domestic water piping
- Plumbing insulation, piping, fixtures, valves and specialties
- Replacing walls and ceilings that were removed for construction
- Required cutting, fitting and patching
- Replace five (5) domestic water heaters
- Replace all mop sinks with stainless steel backsplashes and shut-off valves
- Interior painting

- Equipment wiring
- Conduct all operations to minimize interference with adjacent facilities, user spaces, common areas, and pedestrian ways.

Background History:

The Fulton County Government Center (FCGC) is approximately a 627,000 sf complex of interconnected buildings consisting of the following: Assembly Hall Building, Low Rise Building, Midrise Building, Public Safety Building, Atrium, and High Rise Building. The domestic water service lines to the Government Center complex and risers within the buildings are failing. The piping is galvanized steel and is original to the building and potentially hazardous. Leaks exist at numerous locations along the lines and new ones seem to appear weekly, debris in water and scaling inside the main pipeline.

Some small sections of the water line have been replaced by a Standby On-Call Plumbing contractor. However, it was found that the corrosion and scaling has occurred for lengths beyond the repaired sections. Because the extent of such damage could not be determined, a decision was made to replace the entire length of the main domestic water lines and all branches, including the valves installed in these sections, along with the janitor sinks and some hot water heaters.

The overall primary purpose of the project is to completely replace the galvanized steel piping with copper piping.

The BOC approved Phase I, on October 17, 2018, as Item #18-0757 in the amount of \$325,000 with J Squared Plumbing Co., to provide urgent domestic water piping replacement at the Fulton County Government Center Complex Project. The affected areas were the Mid Rise, Low Rise buildings and Assembly Hall, a total of 220,083 square feet. The intent of Phase I was to replace the existing 4" galvanized steel lines with new 4" insulated copper lines.

Community Impact: This replacement is necessary for the environmental health to have working plumbing systems to protect the patrons and employees in County buildings.

Department Recommendation: The Department of Real Estate and Asset Management recommends approval of the lowest bidder to provide Phase II of the continuing domestic water piping replacement at the Fulton County Government Center Complex Tower and Public Safety Buildings located at 141 Pryor Street, SW, Atlanta, Georgia 30303.

The recommendation was based on the bidders' cost for removing and replacing approximately 920 lineal feet of domestic water piping, furnishing and installing associated equipment, and performing necessary restoration work as required in the Scope of Work. These costs includes: base bid lump sum; allowances for given specified amounts which includes: ball valves @ \$30,000 and access panels @ \$5,000; and including a \$50,000 Owner-Contingency; and total-up all Lump Sums (lines items 1-4) to determine the lowest responsible bidder.

The County received and evaluated one (1) bid response to the solicitation. J Squared Plumbing submitted the only bid (Single Bidder) response for the Domestic Water Piping Replacement Project II. The Purchasing Department conducted a Single Bid Analysis. Therefore, we recommend the award to J Squared Plumbing Co., Inc. to provide domestic water piping replacement at the Fulton County Government Center Complex Tower and Public Safety Buildings.

J Squared Plumbing Co., Inc. has performed very good and highly competent as a plumbing contractor (Standby Plumbing Repair Services- Bid#16ITB58461C-MT) for Fulton County as stated in their performance reports.

The Project Management is coordinated by the Department of Real Estate and Asset Management Project Management Team and Building Maintenance Division. The estimated time to complete the required water piping replacement is 180 calendar days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed and Purchase Order with lead time of materials and equipment.

Project Implications: This contract is necessary for handling such urgent situations, which early on this year serious property damage occurred to the County and could cause health problems to the staff and visitors if this matter not dealt with immediately. The domestic water main lines and branches are showing signs of deterioration, and have developed leaks in several areas. In lieu of creating a patchwork of sections that have, or will be replaced over time, it is recommended to remove and replace all of the galvanized steel water mains, and the deteriorated branch piping as required. The overall primary purpose of the project is to complete the continuation of the water main replacement project that was started in Phase I in the remaining areas of the Government Center Tower and Public Safety Building by replacing the galvanized steel piping with copper piping.

Community Issues/Concerns: None that the Department is aware of.

Department Issues/Concerns: If this contract is not approved, the County does not have the capacity to provide the required corrective water piping replacement on a timely basis in the Fulton County Center Complex.

History of BOC Agenda Item: This is a new procurement.
