1 **RESOLUTION APPROVING** Α UNDERGROUND EASEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND GEORGIA POWER COMPANY FOR 2 THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING ELECTRICAL UTILITY SERVICE EQUIPMENT AT 3 1838 DONALD LEE HOLLOWELL PARKWAY, ATLANTA, GEORGIA, FORMALLY 4 KNOWN AS THE DOGWOOD BRANCH LIBRARY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN 5 TO EXECUTE A UNDERGROUND EASEMENT AGREEMENT AND RELATED 6 7 DOCUMENTS; TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO APPROVE AS TO FORM AND MAKE MODIFICATIONS AS NECESSARY PRIOR TO EXECUTION: AND 8 FOR OTHER PURPOSES 9

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WHEREAS, Fulton County, Georgia ("Fulton County") is a political subdivision of

- 12 the State of Georgia, existing as such under and by the Constitution, statutes, and laws
- 13 of the State; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Fulton County Department of Library Services operates libraries

15 throughout Fulton County that offer a wide array of services for the residents of Fulton

16 County and the public; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Georgia Power Company is converting its overhead electric 18 distribution lines to underground electric distribution lines in order to improve service

reliability and the existing grid infrastructure within the community; and

20 WHEREAS, the planned onsite utility improvements at Dogwood Branch Library

21 include a Three Phase Terminating Cabinet and a Pull Box that will be installed onsite

22 adjacent to the right of way of Donald Lee Howell Parkway; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Georgia Power Company and the Fulton County Department of Real Estate and Asset Management that a utility easement will be required to install the aforementioned electrical service equipment and to relocate overhead service lines underground; and

WHEREAS, The Fulton County Department of Real Estate and Asset Management recommends approval for the granting of a utility easement to the Georgia Power Company at 1838 Donald Lee Hollowell Parkway, Atlanta, Georgia 30318, formally known as the Dogwood Branch Library, in Fulton County, Georgia, located in
the 14th District and Land Lot 176 and more particularly described in Exhibit "A",
attached hereto; and

4 **WHEREAS**, 36-10-1, "[a]Il contracts entered into by the county governing 5 authority with other persons in behalf of the county shall be in writing and entered on its 6 minutes".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of
Fulton County, Georgia, hereby approves of the conveyance of utility easement from
Fulton County to Georgia Power Company, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A"
attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of Fulton County Board of Commissioners be authorized and directed to execute and deliver a utility easement agreement and other necessary documents to Georgia Power Company to complete the grant of easement rights.

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that prior to execution of any documents, the 16 County Attorney shall approve any and all documents as to form and make any 17 necessary substantive changes thereto to protect the County's interests.

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall become effective upon its 19 adoption and that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution 20 are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
