WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, on September 19, 2018, via Resolution 18-0672, set the rate of compensation for members serving on the Board of Equalization at \$100.00 per day; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in Fulton County's best interest to increase such rate of compensation from \$100.00 per day to \$150.00 per day.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the per diem rate for Board of Equalization members shall increase in alignment with all county wide cost of living increases for Fulton County employees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Commissioners, that the rate of compensation paid to each member serving on the Fulton County Boards of Equalization is increased from \$100.00 per day to \$150.00 per day.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Clerk to the Commission shall provide a copy of this Resolution to the Finance Department and the Fulton County Boards of Equalization.
