AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 101 (GENERAL PROVISIONS AND COUNTY GOVERNING AUTHORITY), ARTICLE 2 (COUNTY GOVERNING AUTHORITY), DIVISION 2 (RULES OF ORDER AND PROCEDURE), SECTION 101-68 (DECORUM) OF THE FULTON COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of Fulton County, Georgia (the "County") is the Fulton County Board of Commissioners (the "BOC"); and

WHEREAS, the Board has the authority, pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Georgia, Article 9, Sec. 2 ¶ 1(a), to adopt reasonable ordinances, resolutions, or regulations relating to the County's affairs for which no provision has been made by general law and which is not inconsistent with the Constitution or any local law applicable thereto; and

WHEREAS, in conformity with the provisions of the Open Meetings Act, O.C.G.A. § 50-14-1 *et seq.*, the Board enacted certain provisions of its Rules of Order and Procedure (the "Rules") at its Regular Meeting on January 5, 1994, with said regulations being codified in Chapter 101 (General Provisions and County Governing Authority), Article II (County Governing Authority), Division 2 (Rules of Order and Procedure) of the Fulton County Code of Ordinances ("Code") as Section 101-61 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2025, via Agenda Item 24-0908, the Board of Commissioners last modified its Rules of Order and Procedure, specifically the text of FCC Sec. 101-68 (Decorum), to specify additional conduct that it deems disruptive and inappropriate for commissioners and staff and to discourage such conduct by increasing the penalties imposed for violation of the Board's decorum guidelines; and

27	WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners continues to recognize the need for
28	clear and enforceable guidelines for what is appropriate conduct by each member of the
29	Board of Commissioners during official meetings, as well as the need to enforce the
30	penalties imposed for engaging in prohibited conduct by amending the penalties
31	currently imposed for violation of the Board's decorum guidelines.
32	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the Fulton County Board of
33	Commissioners hereby amends Section 101-68 of the Fulton County Code of
34	Ordinances by adding and striking language to the Code Section as follows:
35	"Sec. 101-68. – Decorum.
36	
37	(c) Reserved.
38	(d) Penalties.
39	(1) For each violation by a commissioner, the violator may be subject to the
40	following penalties:
41	a. Administrative sanction.
42	1. For a first violation by the violator of this section, the board may
43	impose upon the violator an administrative sanction in an
44	amount not to exceed <del>\$500.00,</del> <b>\$1,000.00.</b>
45	2. For a second violation by the violator of this section that occurs
46	within 12 months after a first violation by him or her, the board
47	may impose upon the violator an administrative sanction in an

amount not to exceed \$1,000.00, \$3,000.00.

49	3. For a third (or subsequent) violation by the violator of this
50	section that occurs within 12 months after the first violation by
51	him or her, the board may impose upon the violator an
52	administrative sanction in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00,
53	<u>\$5,000.00.</u>
54	4. A second violation of this section by a violator that occurs more
55	than 12 months after a prior violation by him or her shall be
56	treated as a first violation under subsection (d)(1) a.1.
57	<del>5</del>
58	4. The Finance Department shall deduct the monetary value of
59	the administrative sanction from the violator's paycheck for the
60	next pay period occurring after the imposition of the sanction.
61	BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall become effective when
62	passed and adopted, and that all ordinances and resolutions and parts of ordinances
63	and resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the
64	conflict.
