WHEREAS, Fulton County ("County") entered into a Contract with AT&T Mobility, LLC, to provide wireless communication services and equipment, effective the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2017, on behalf of the Information Technology Department.

This critical service will help ensure priority of communication for first responders in a potential time of crisis.
