RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF A SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AND THE 2015-2019 CONSOLIDATED PLAN AND THEIR SUBMITTAL TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE 2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN OF THE 2015-2019 CONSOLIDATED PLAN'S EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) ACTIVITIES FOR THE USE OF THE EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT COVID-19 FUNDING OF \$2,529,828 IN ESG-CV FUNDS FROM HUD: AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO DISBUSERE THE ESG-CV FUNDS FROM HUD, EXECUTE AND ADMINISTER CONTRACTS AND RELATED DOCUMENTS CONSISTENT WITH THESE DISBURSEMENTS AND THE FEDERAL PROGRAMS: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development "HUD") is authorized to extend financial assistance to communities in the elimination or prevention of slums or urban blight, or activities which will benefit low- and moderate-income persons or other urgent community development needs; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) of 2020 made available supplemental Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding for grants to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the CARES Act made available supplemental ESG funding for grants to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus (hereinafter ESG-CV grants, respectively"); and

WHEREAS, the provision of services to address the needs of low- and moderate income residents of Fulton County is a vital activity necessary to the maintenance and continues growth and development to both the County and the region; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County maintains an active partnership with HUD to promote development and provide services to address the needs of low- and moderate-income citizens through the ESG Programs and their amendments; and

WHEREAS, HUD regulations require that substantial changes in funding, goals or

activities require a substantial amendment to the Consolidated Plan as set forth in 24 CFR Part 29 91, which includes: a significant change to an activity, scope of work, location, beneficiaries, or 30 persons served; and funding of a new activity not previously described in the FY 2019 Action Plan; and 32

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WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners adopted the 2015 through the 2019 Consolidated Plan (Item #15-0503); and

WHEREAS, the County has prepared a Substantial Amendment to its FY 2019 Annual Action Plan to outline the proposed ESG-CV grant activities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the adoption of a Substantial Amendment to the 2019 Annual Action Plan and the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan, along with their submission with a list of proposed activities to HUD and directs the application of all funds secured by this submittal to activities that benefit low- and moderate-income residents of Fulton County as directed by the Board of Commissioners and HUD; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners hereby approves the substantial amendment to reduce funding in the Outreach (\$188,550.22), Rapid Rehousing (\$100,889.13), and Administration (\$16,674.43) ESG CV activities and move the funding to the Emergency Shelter (\$56,680.24) and Homeless Prevention (\$249,433.54) ESG CV activities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of Fulton County all supplemental intergovernmental agreements, contracts, and related documents of papers, as necessary and consistent with these awards, program amendments and this Resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the County Attorney is hereby authorized to approve as to form all supplemental intergovernmental agreements, contracts, and related documents of
