WHEREAS,

Christopher scored many R&B hits, including *I'm Dreamin'* in 1991, which became a number one single on Billboard's Hot R&B/Hip-Hop Singles & Tracks charts, and was included on the *New Jack City* movie soundtrack; and



WHEREAS,

Christopher has collaborated with many fellow artists and contributed to several movie soundtracks; he was also a part of the group Black Men United for the hit single *U Will Know* from the *Jason's Lyric* movie soundtrack; and



WHEREAS,

Christopher is also an actor who appeared in the 1991 film *New Jack City* in the role of Kareem Akbar; he



also had a cameo appearance in the 1990s police drama *New York Undercover*, and another cameo in *Gunmen*, singing a song titled *Stranger in My Life*; and

Christopher has also starred or co-starred in several successful off-Broadway theatre productions during

the 2000s, including A Good Man Is Hard to Find, A House Is Not a Home, Men Cry in the Dark, The Love You Save, and The Man He Used to Be; The Clean-up



Woman, and many others;
