

Proclamation



WHEREAS,

Fulton County Government uses web accessibility to ensure that Fulton County communities use web accessibility for people with disabilities to contribute to building and maintaining a healthy community in every aspect of life; and



WHEREAS,

Fulton County, through its public agencies and with cooperative assistance of Accessibility for Life, Disability Awareness Now, Sense of Equity, and other accessibility advocacy organizations, should facilitate the expansion of web accessibility for and greater acceptance of persons with disabilities to have the choice to fully participate in all aspects of life; and



WHEREAS,

Fulton County law also calls upon employers, both public and private, to be aware of and utilize web accessibility as a means to give the Fulton County citizens the choice to fully participate in Fulton County in every aspect of life; and



WHEREAS,

every citizen should be aware that the law requires that instructions for using indoor and outdoor paths of travel must be provided to the public by websites that meet the requirement of web accessibility of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Fulton County Board of Commissioners recognizes that web accessibility is essential for all citizens, including those with disabilities, for a high quality of life, and does hereby proclaim Wednesday, December 20, 2023 as **"CODAWEB ACCESSIBILITY APPRECIATION DAY"** in Fulton County, Georgia.
