Q is a native of Atlanta, Georgia whose musical journey began at an early age as he developed his vocals and passion for performing; and

in addition to his music career, Q is a husband, father, grandfather, entrepreneur and philanthropist; he is the founder of Q Parker Legacy Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization founded in 2015 and inspired by the mission of strengthening families throughout the City of Atlanta by focusing on holistic, cross-generational approaches rooted in family engagement and social empowerment; and

Q has also formed Paramount Collective Ventures as an independent artist, and he gives back to the community through the Annual Senior Caroling Gala, focused on the senior community in Atlanta, and the Annual Summer Music Camp, which creates a safe, creative, and inspiring space where aspiring vocalists, musicians, and performers are trained by industry professionals; and

Q's influential roles in Brothers United of Atlanta and the Bridge Project showcase his deep commitment to cultural unity and social change, as he continues to support these and other community initiatives focused on health, wellness, and youth mentorship;
