Peter J. Nash, known by his stage name Prime Minister Pete Nice, or Pete Nice, has a diverse career spanning hip-hop, baseball history, authorship, and business ventures; and



*WHEREAS,*

Pete Nice grew up in Greenpoint, Brooklyn, New York and graduated magna cum laude from Columbia University with a degree in English; and



*WHEREAS,*

Pete Nice's career in music began with the formation of the rap group Sin Qua Non while he was in high school; he continued with a solo career and later collaborated with other artists for the formation of 3<sup>rd</sup> Bass, named in honor of his love of baseball; and



*WHEREAS,*

Pete Nice is a prominent hip-hop historian who documents the evolution of hip-hop through rare posters, flyers, and pictures; he is also a co-curator for the Universal Hip Hop Museum, and collaborator on a book titled *The Golden Age of Hip Hop: An Illustrative History*; and



*WHEREAS,*

Pete Nice owned a memorabilia shop in Cooperstown, New York and authored *Baseball Legends of Brooklyn's Green-Wood Cemetery*; he's also been involved in efforts to secure an official gravesite for Negro League players;
