- A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER AND THE COUNTY
  ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND PRESENT TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
  AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) BETWEEN FULTON COUNTY,
  GEORGIA, THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, AND THE ATLANTA BOARD OF
  EDUCATION TO SHARE IN THE COSTS RELATED TO AN INDEPENDENT AUDIT OF
  THE APPRAISED VALUE OF CERTAIN COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES LOCATED
  WITHIN FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
  - **WHEREAS,** Fulton County, Georgia is a political subdivision of the State of Georgia; and

- WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta is a municipal corporation chartered by the State of Georgia; and
  - WHEREAS, the Atlanta Independent School System, is a political subdivision of the State of Georgia under the management and control of the Atlanta Board of Education; and
  - **WHEREAS**, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners, pursuant to state law (O.C.G.A. § 48-5-290), and by resolution (93-RC-632), established the Fulton County Board of Tax Assessors; and
  - WHEREAS, the Board of Tax Assessors was established for the purpose of filling the duties and functions of tax assessors with respect to the assessment and fixing of the value of all taxable property located within the boundaries of Fulton County, and the City of Atlanta within Fulton County, for all state, county, city, school and other tax purposes, including the giving of notices of assessments, as well as hearing appeals with respect to such assessments; and
  - WHEREAS, the Board of Tax Assessors, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 48-5-299, must investigate diligently and inquire into the property owned in the county for the purpose of ascertaining what real and personal property is subject to taxation in the county and to require the proper return of the property for taxation; and
  - **WHEREAS**, as reported by the *Atlanta Journal-Constitution* on May 24, 2019 and August 9, 2019, and the *Atlanta Magazine* on January 6, 2023, the results of an internal county audit revealed that Fulton County, the City of Atlanta, and the Atlanta Public School System are not able to collect tens of millions of dollars a year in potential revenue due to the undervaluing of commercial properties across Fulton County; and
  - **WHEREAS**, Fulton County, the City of Atlanta, and the Atlanta Board of Education recognize that the real estate market is resurging and thriving; and
  - **WHEREAS**, Fulton County, the City of Atlanta, and the Atlanta Board of Education believe it is necessary to determine the cause of underassessed large commercial properties within Fulton County; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County, the City of Atlanta, and the Atlanta Board of Education desire to support an independent audit regarding the assessment and appeals process for large commercial properties within Fulton County; and WHEREAS, Fulton County, the City of Atlanta, and the Atlanta Board of Education desire to share in the costs of an independent audit led by the Fulton County Auditor, whereby the costs and resources needed to perform the audit will be determined at a later date, which will be effectuated via an intergovernmental agreement ("IGA") between the governmental entities; and WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners believes it is in the best

**WHEREAS**, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners believes it is in the best interest of its citizens to enter into an IGA with the City of Atlanta and the Atlanta Board of Education to share in the costs of an independent audit of certain commercial properties located within Fulton County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners finds that authorizing the County Manager and County Attorney to negotiate the terms and conditions of an IGA between Fulton County, Georgia, the City of Atlanta, and the Atlanta Board of Education, and present this IGA to the Board of Commissioners for consideration would serve the best interest of all of its citizens.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby directs and authorizes the County Manager and the County Attorney to negotiate the terms and conditions of an IGA between Fulton County, Georgia, the City of Atlanta, Georgia and the Atlanta Board of Education, to share in all costs related to an independent audit on the valuation of commercial properties located within Fulton County.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** the County Manager and the County Attorney are directed to present the IGA to the Board of Commissioners for consideration at an upcoming Board of Commissioners' meeting for consideration.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption, and that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
