RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH NEW SUPPLEMENTS FOR SUPERIOR COURT JUDGES. 1 THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY AND THE CIRCUIT PUBLIC DEFENDER AFTER SUPPORTIVE 2 3 OPINION RECEIVED FROM THE ATTORNEY GENERAL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. 4 5 WHEREAS, the last time the Board of Commissioners comprehensively evaluated the 6 compensation of many of the County's elected officials and state appointees was on January 7 21,1998, when it adopted "Resolution Providing for an Increase in Compensation for Fulton County Employees" ("1998 Compensation Resolution"); and 8 9 WHEREAS, on November 17, 2021, in Agenda Item No. 21-0913, the Department of Human Resources Management ("DHRM") presented the Board of Commissioners a proposal to 10 establish new salaries and/or county supplements for elected and appointed officials to the extent 11 12 allowed by law and where such authority is vested in the Board of Commissioners; and WHEREAS, DHRM's compensation model did not include tethering the salaries or 13 14 supplements for elected and appointed officials to the compensation of other elected officials; and 15 WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners ("BOC"), recognizing the salaries and/or county

supplements of certain elected and appointed officials are not currently at market rates based on the size of their operations and the compensation of their counterparts in other counties, approved the new compensation model presented by DHRM which is based on specific roles of each official and departs from using a waterfall approach that tethers the total compensation to the Superior and State Court Judges of Fulton County.

WHEREAS, the base salary of the judges of the superior court is set forth in O.C.G.A. § 45-7-4(a)20; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 15-6-29(c) authorizes a county supplement to be paid to superior court judges but provides that the amount of such county supplement must be created and changed by local legislation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 2013 Ga. L. 4397, the County supplement for Fulton County Superior Court Judges was set at \$49,748; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-6-29.1(c), "on and after January 1, 2016, no county or counties comprising the circuit shall increase an aggregate county salary supplement paid to a superior court judge, if such supplement is \$50,000.00 or more"; and

WHEREAS, DHRM has recommended increasing the county supplement paid to the Superior Court Judges for the Atlanta Judicial Circuit to an amount that is greater than \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the County Attorney has requested an opinion from the Attorney General of Georgia clarifying the authority of the BOC to increase the County supplement paid to the Superior Court Judges to an amount above \$50,000.

District Attorney

WHEREAS, the base salary of the district attorney is set forth in O.C.G.A. § 45-7-4(a)(21); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-18-11, the governing authority of a county may provide a county supplement to the district attorney for the judicial circuit where the county lies; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County is the only county comprising the Atlanta Judicial Circuit; and WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-18-10.1(d), "on or after January 1, 2016, no county or counties comprising the circuit shall increase an aggregate county salary supplement paid to the district attorney or a state paid position appointed pursuant to this article, if such supplement is \$50,000.00 or more"; and

WHEREAS, the County has used the 1998 Compensation Resolution, which provides that the compensation for the district attorney be "equal to the total compensation of the Superior Court Judges including the percentage of an increase in State compensation which may be received July 1, 1998" as a basis to determine the supplement paid to the District Attorney for the Atlanta Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, the supplement paid to the District Attorney for the Atlanta Judicial Circuit is less than \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, DHRM has recommended increasing the county supplement paid to the District Attorney for the Atlanta Judicial Circuit to an amount that is greater than \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the County Attorney has requested an opinion from the Attorney General of Georgia that will provide clarification as to the authority of the BOC to increase the County supplement paid to the District Attorney to an amount above \$50,000.

Circuit Public Defender

WHEREAS, the base salary of circuit public defenders is set forth in O.C.G.A. § 17-12-25(a); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 17-12-25(b), the General Assembly by local law or the county governing authority for the judicial circuit may establish a county supplement for a circuit public defender, the greater of which shall prevail as the county supplement to be paid; and

WHEREAS, DHRM has recommended increasing the supplement paid to the Circuit Public Defender for the Atlanta Judicial Circuit to an amount that is greater than \$50,000; and

1 WHEREAS, the County Attorney has requested an opinion from the Attorney General of 2 Georgia that will provide clarification as to the authority of the BOC to increase the County 3 supplement paid to the Circuit Public Defender to an amount above \$50,000. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the BOC hereby adopts a new county 4 5 supplement for the Superior Court Judges to be included in the Salaries and Supplements Schedule attached hereto subject to a) an opinion received from the Attorney General supporting 6 7 the authority of the County to increase the supplement amount above \$50,000 and b) adoption of further legislation to the extent it is required. 8 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the BOC hereby adopts new county supplements for 10 the District Attorney and Circuit Public Defender as outlined in the Salaries and Supplements Schedule attached hereto subject to an opinion received from the Attorney General supporting 11 the authority of the County to increase the supplement amount above \$50,000. 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the supplements authorized by this Resolution shall 13 14 become effective only when the contingencies stated herein are satisfied and on the first day of the applicable pay cycle that starts immediately after such contingencies are satisfied. 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DHRM shall review the supplements of the elected 16 17 and appointed officials referenced herein in tandem and as part of future county-wide 18 classification and compensation salary surveys. 19 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with 20 this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict. 21 PASSED AND ADOPTED this _____ day of ______, 2022. 22 **FULTON COUNTY** 23 **BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS** 24 25 26 27 Chairman Robert L.
