Hello all,

Update on the MRR funds for computer replacement being available starting July 1st below - distribution formula attached.

- This is NEW:
- How much do I get? Attached please find a spreadsheet detailing out the distribution of funds. We tweaked the
 formula this year as follows: Last year, we weighted the categories of "population" and "county" equally. In order
 to try to increase computing footprints and to reach as many patrons as possible, this year, we weighted "county"
 at 1/3 and "population" at 2/3.
- . This is the same as Last Week:
- Everything, including forms, deadlines, vendor discounts, etc. will be posted on the MRR webpage by July 1st.
- What's allowed and what's not allowed? Here's the Intention for MRR funds document. Take a look and let me
 know if there are any questions.
- What kinds of deals are we getting? We already have deals lined up with CDW-G, Google, AWE, Amazon, etc. We are working to get the very best deal for you on the broadest range of products you can use. These will all be final and up on our page by July 1st.
- How do I make my plan? Same form as last year fill it out within the constraints of the Intention document, we'll
 OK it, and you are free to procure.
- How do I get my money back? Same process as last year once you have COMPLETED your purchases, fill
 out the reimbursement form, provide copies of your invoices, send everything to Nicol, and we'll turn it around
 within 14 days.

PUBLIC ACCESS COMPUTING - Intention for MRR funds

We have fielded a number of questions regarding what items are appropriate to be purchased under this grant. This allocation was specifically targeted as "public computer replacement." While we are trying to interpret this as broadly as possible to allow you maximum flexibility to address diverse needs, we acknowledge the advisability of staying true to legislative intent. As we fully plan to request MRR funds for technology again next year, we see the importance of being able to point to public access equipment when publicizing the results of this grant, especially to the legislators who have and will continue to support it.

You are strongly urged to use these funds for equipment that will be used by the public, perhaps in new and different ways, if your basic needs are already met. We will not approve the purchase of furniture or staff equipment.

The MRR funds distributed will be for the procurement of public access computing machines.

This encompasses:

- Desktop PC's
- AWE Early Literacy Stations
- Laptops
- Tablets
- Ereaders
- Thin Clients
- Google Chrome boxes & Chrome books
- Printers

This is a broad interpretation of public access computing, insofar as we are attempting to meet as many existing needs as possible without going too far outside the initial intention.

The attached menu includes the above items listed with vendors with whom we have secured bulk discounts. If you would like to order "off the menu" you may do so, as long as it meets the above definition of public access computing and is approved by GPLS via your tech procurement plan.

Intentions for MRR funds

The allocation for these funds is specifically for public access computer replacement and computing infrastructure. We are interpreting this as broadly as possible to allow you maximum flexibility to address diverse needs, while we acknowledge the advisability of staying true to legislative intent.

FY '15 MRR Process Timeline:

- 10.15.2014 Deadline for delivering your MRR purchasing plan to Emily. Any item appearing on the menu is automatically approved. Any item not on the menu will be reviewed in order to ensure it complies with the intention of the MRR funds. (Flummoxed by all of the choices? Please check out the Tech Learning Kits page to get a good idea of what it is, how to use, etc.)
- 10.30.2014 Deadline for tech plans to be approved by GPLS. Items on the bulk discount menu automatically approved; "off-menu" items will be reviewed in order to ensure they comply with the intention of the MRR funds.
- 11.31.2014 Procurement deadline Orders placed with vendors either on the bulk discount menu or "offmenu."
- 12.15.2014 Deadline for libraries to file <u>MRR Reimbursement Request Form</u> & provide copies of invoices to <u>Nicol</u>. Library systems will be reimbursed within 14 days of filing completed form.
