

1 **RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FULTON COUNTY,**
2 **GEORGIA, SUPPORTING A PROPOSED REDISTRICTING PLAN FOR THE**
3 **FULTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS; REQUESTING THAT ITS**
4 **LOCAL LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION HAVE SUCH PROPOSED REDISTRICTING**
5 **PLAN INTRODUCED AS LOCAL LEGISLATION AT THE 2022 REGULAR SESSION**
6 **OF THE GEORGIA GENERAL ASSEMBLY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE**
7 **DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

10 **WHEREAS**, the 2020 Decennial Census has been completed and the results thereof have
11 been submitted to the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County, Georgia; and
12

13 **WHEREAS**, such 2020 Census reflects that the population of Fulton County increased by
14 146,129 to 1,066,710, and
15

16 **WHEREAS**, the County Commission Districts for elected members of the Fulton County
17 Board of Commissioners must be redrawn in order to comply with federal and state guidelines,
18 including the principle of “one person, one vote”; and
19

20 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners desires to submit a proposed redistricting plan
21 to its local legislative delegation to the Georgia General Assembly so that such proposed
22 redistricting plan can be approved by the General Assembly at its 2022 regular session and then
23 signed by the Governor; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the Legislative and Congressional Reapportionment Office of the Georgia
26 General Assembly will review the proposed plan for technical and legal compliance purposes; and

28 **WHEREAS**, the plan will receive certification by the Legislative and Congressional
29 Reapportionment Office of the Georgia General Assembly prior to adoption; and

31 **WHEREAS**, the principle of “one person, one vote,” and other legal compliance matters
32 have been addressed, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners has determined this proposed
33 plan to be the most appropriate redistricting plan for the Fulton County Commissioners and
34 citizens of Fulton County; and

36 **WHEREAS**, pending certification by the Legislative and Congressional Reapportionment
37 Office of the Georgia General Assembly, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners expresses
38 its support for the proposed redistricting plan;

40 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners, acting in its
41 capacity as the governing authority of Fulton County, as follows:

43 (1) The Board of Commissioners hereby supports the proposed redistricting plan attached
44 as Exhibit A.
45

46 (2) The Board of Commissioners hereby requests that its local legislative delegation to the
47 Georgia General Assembly draft and introduce during the 2022 regular session of the Georgia
48 General Assembly such proposed redistricting plan for passage by the Georgia General Assembly
49 and signing by the Governor.

2 (3) This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

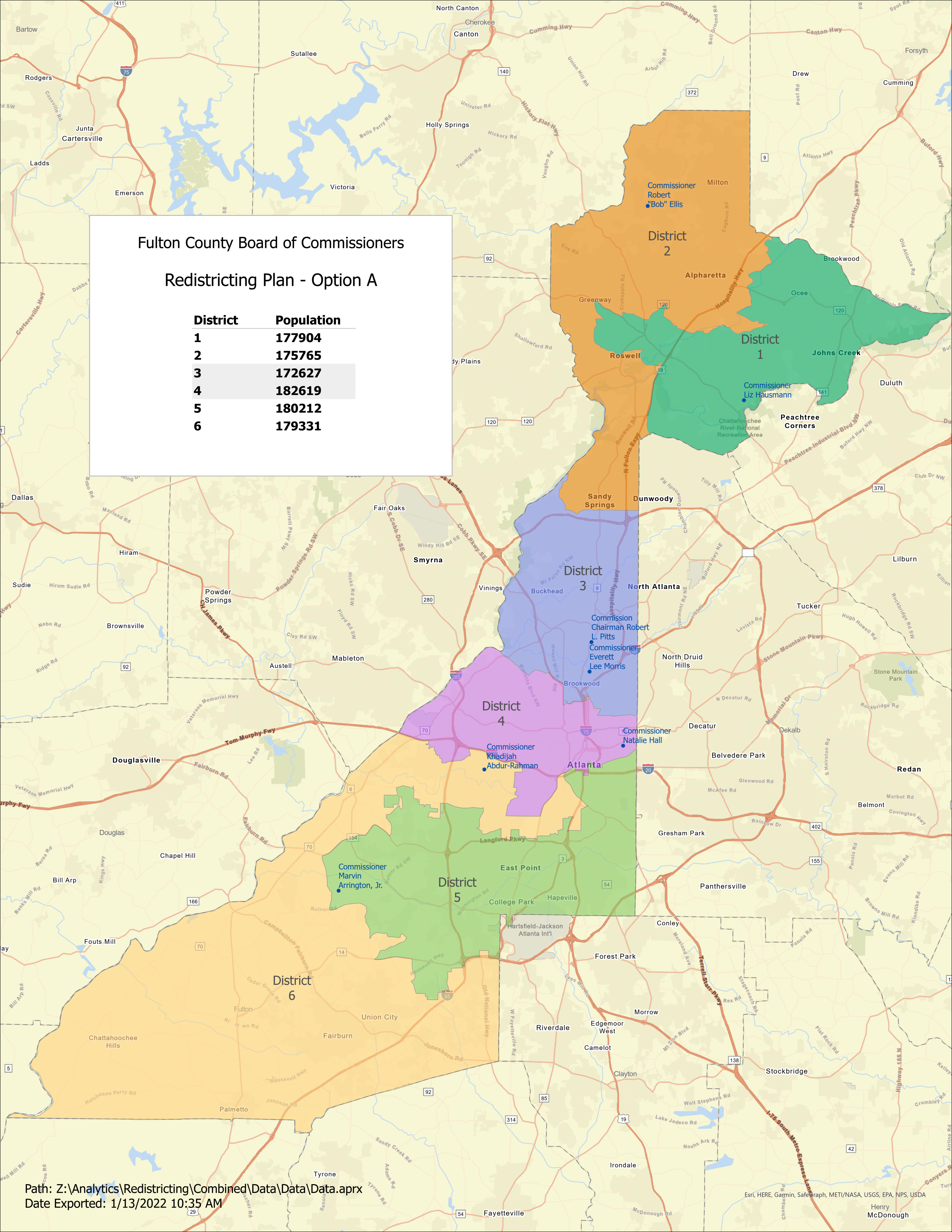

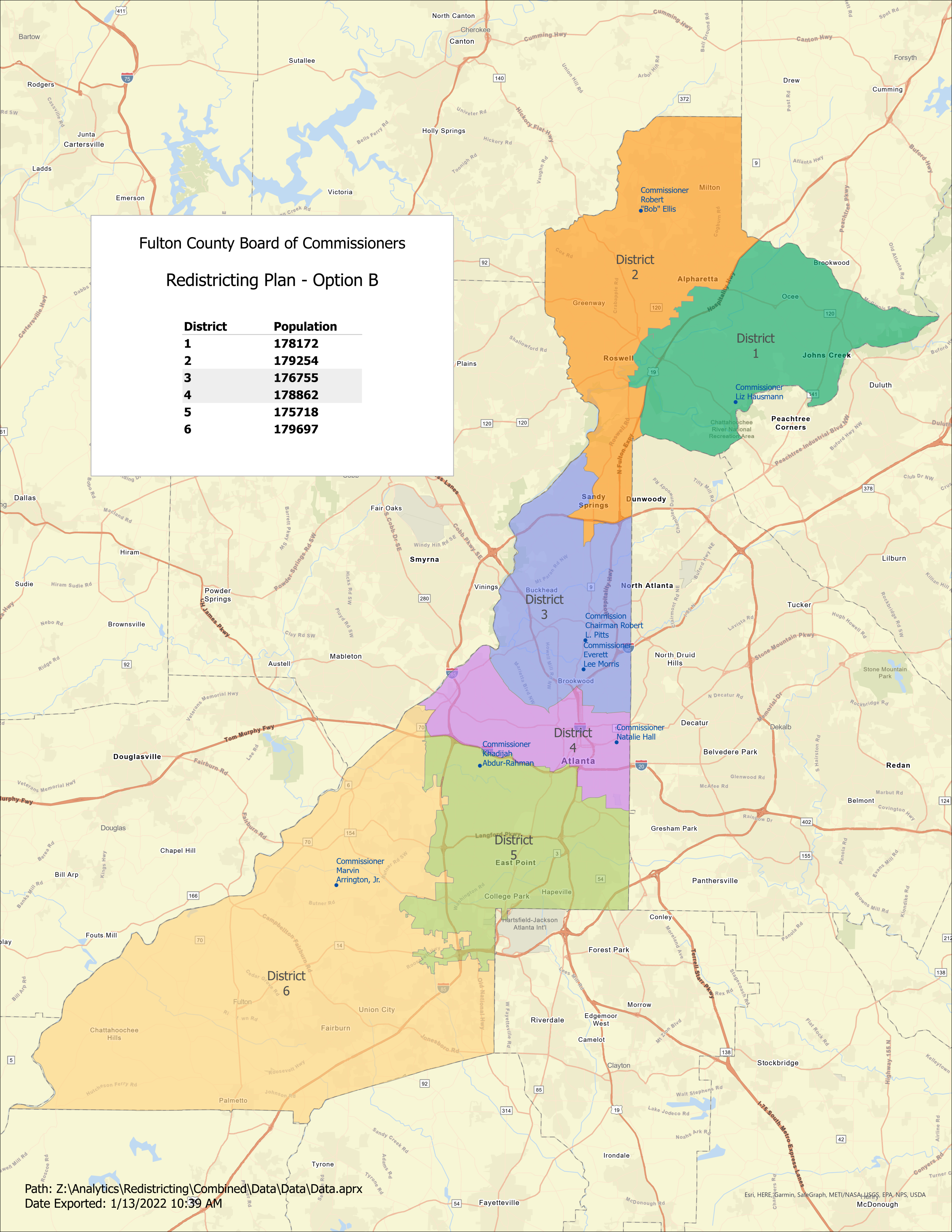
Fulton County Board of Commissioners Redistricting Plan - Option A

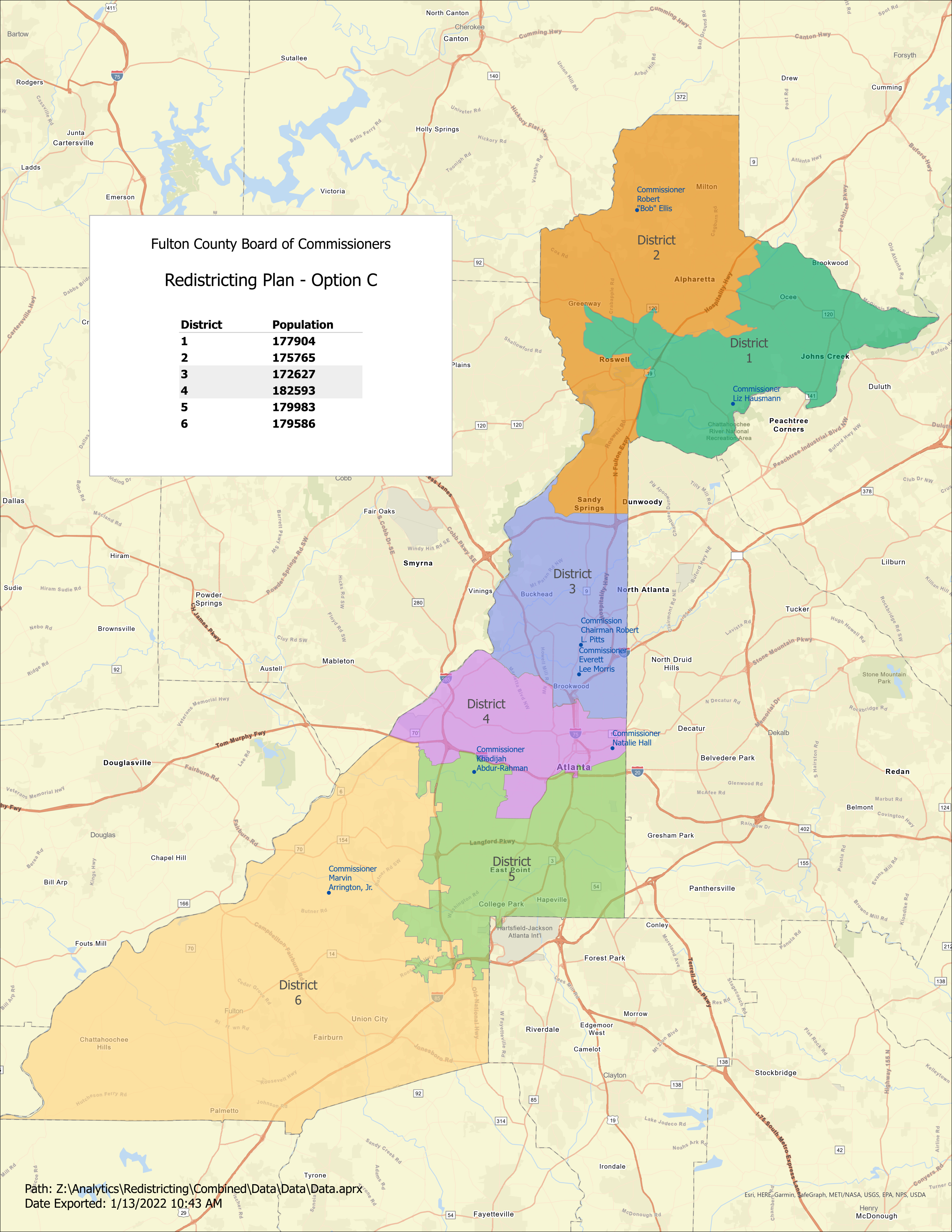
Fulton County Board of Commissioners Redistricting Plan - Option B
