A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE FULTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS RECEIVE REGULAR UPDATES FROM THE COUNTY MANAGER REGARDING CONDITIONS, CONCERNS, AND IMPROVEMENTS AT THE FULTON COUNTY JAIL FACILITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, operation of the Fulton County Jail Facilities are a crucial aspect of law enforcement and the criminal justice system in Fulton County; and

WHEREAS, operations of the Fulton County Jail facilities impact the health, safety, and welfare of thousands of inmates and their families, employees and their families, residents, visitors, and businesses in Fulton County and beyond; and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners recognizes Sheriff Patrick "Pat" Labat and the Sheriff's Office have undertaken significant initiatives to improve the conditions, operations, and safety of Fulton County Jail facilities and will continue to seek further improvements; and

WHEREAS, conditions at the main jail have recently become a source of increased public interest among residents, the media, concerned citizens, and the general public; and

WHEREAS, increased public interest in the Fulton County Jail facilities has resulted in increased constituent inquiries to members of the Fulton County Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners endeavors to have the most thorough and up to date information possible regarding jail conditions, operations, and safety in order to serve its constituents in the most effective manner.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby requests monthly updates from the County Manager regarding personnel, jail conditions, medical care, building maintenance, and utilization of Fulton County Jail facilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby requests that the monthly updates regarding facility utilization include jail population relative to physical capacity at the Rice Street Jail, Marietta Annex, Alpharetta Jail, Union City Jail, and Atlanta City Detention Center, as well as the number of Fulton County inmates housed outside of the current County owned facilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby requests that the monthly updates include information regarding staffing, including the actual number of current vacancies and separations year to date for the total department as well as the actual number of current vacancies and separations year to date for detention officers and deputies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby requests that Fulton County Sheriff's Office resumes monthly calls with the County Manager's office and the jail facilities medical provider.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby requests the cooperation of the Fulton County Sheriff's Office in the supplying of necessary data such that the requested information can be provided to the Board of Commissioners on a monthly basis by the County Manager.
