

# Proclamation



**WHEREAS,**

On February 3, 1958, President Dwight D. Eisenhower issued a proclamation establishing Law Day in the United States as a day celebrating and commemorating the United States Legal System and its contribution to preservation of justice and human rights; and



**WHEREAS,**

in 1961, the United States Congress designated May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year as the official date for celebrating Law Day by passing a joint resolution; and



**WHEREAS,**

Law Day provides an opportunity for citizens of Fulton County to appreciate the liberties provided to them, especially with regard to equality and justice; and



**WHEREAS,**

Law Day further provides an opportunity to learn and cultivate respect for the law which is vital to the democratic way of life; and



**WHEREAS,**

the theme for Law Day 2025 is "Out of Many, One", which urges us to take pride in a Constitution that bridges our differences to bring us together as a united nation, and remind us that our civic lives tie us together as one; and



**WHEREAS,**

Fulton County urges everyone to observe this day by promoting law and education and fulfilling our shared civic responsibilities and commitment to the values of liberty, equality, and justice that make us "Out of Many, One";




**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** That the Fulton County Board of Commissioners commemorates the importance of the observance of Law Day, and does hereby proclaim Thursday, May 1, 2025, as "**LAW DAY**" in Fulton County, Georgia.
