For 50 years, NATAS Southeast has proudly presented the Southeast Emmy Awards, the benchmark of excellence in the television industry, bestowing thousands of Emmy® statuettes, 29 Gold Circle Awards (for 50-year service honorees), and 216 Silver Circle Awards (for 25-year service honorees), and in 2024, established the "Evelyn Mims-Darryl Cohen Lifetime Service Award Presented by SNAG Enterprises L.C."; and

From its first president, the late Don Elliott Heald, a WSB radio and TV legendary broadcaster and manager, to current president Evelyn D. Mims, the first African-American woman president of a NATAS chapter in the USA, NATAS Southeast continues to set the standard for excellence in the television industry; and

NATAS Southeast has provided thousands of students opportunities to learn and grow in the television industry—many of whom have become professionals—through the Chapter's annual Student Production Awards and through collegiate scholarships; and
