

Community Services Program (CSP) 2025 Funding Recommendations

Community Services Program

The Fulton County Community Services Program (CSP) is one of the County's principal avenue for funding social service programs pursuant to the County's Strategic Plan. CSP addresses six (6) Service Categories: Children & Youth Services, Disabilities, Economic Stability/Poverty, Health and Wellness, Homelessness, and Senior Services.

During the 2024 Community Services Program (January 1-December 31, 2024), there were 53,424 Fulton County Citizens served through 145 non-profit agencies.

The Fulton County Board of Commissioners approved \$5,363,958.00 for the Community Services Program as a part of the FY25 General Fund Budget.

The 2025 CSP RFP was released on February 4, 2025, and closed on March 7, 2025. Two hundred twenty-seven (227) agencies submitted CSP proposals, totaling \$18,885,408.56.

One hundred sixty (160) agencies are being recommended for CSP funding totaling \$5,363,958.00. There are thirteen (13) eligible unfunded agencies. An additional \$325,000.00 would be needed to fund those agencies at their recommended amount.
